

DISPLACEMENT TRACKING

DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects and reports on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs. In the first nine months of 2019, conflict has resulted in new patterns of displacement, particularly in within Hajjah, Al Hudaydah, Al Dhale'e, Taizz governorates.

WEEKLY UPDATE

Between 08 and 14 March, newly displaced households were recorded in Marib (843 HH), Al Hadramaut (264 HH), and Al Taiz (130 HH). Most of these displacements were the result of increased fighting in Al Jawf (1,081 HH), Al Hudaydah (133 HH), and Al Dhale'e (97 HH).

IDP HH WHO LEFT DISPLACED LOCATIONS

47 IDP households left their location of displacement and moved either to their place of origin or to some other displaced location.
