


Overview: As of 24th March 2020 (17:00 CET) data for the initial baseline assessment of Points of Entry (PoE) has been collected and processed for **84** countries/areas as follows **RO Bangkok:** Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Mongolia, Pakistan, Philippines; **RO Brussels:** Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Germany, Ireland, Italy, Lithuania, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, San Marino, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Spain, Switzerland, United Kingdom; **RO Buenos Aires:** Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Ecuador, Peru, Uruguay, Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela; **RO Cairo:** Algeria, Egypt, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Saudi Arabia, Sudan, Syrian Arab Republic, Tunisia, United Arab Emirates, Yemen; **RO Dakar:** Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Chad, Gambia, Guinea, Mali, Mauritania, Nigeria, Senegal; **RO Nairobi:** Djibouti, Ethiopia, Rwanda, Somalia, South Sudan, Uganda; **RO Pretoria:** Botswana, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Madagascar, Mauritius, Mozambique, Namibia, South Africa; **RO San José:** Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Guyana, Honduras, Mexico, Trinidad and Tobago; **RO Vienna:** Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Serbia, Turkey, Ukraine and Kosovo (UN SCR 1244).


The PoE Baseline database contains information on **1,221** points of entry. These consist of **238** airports, **77** internal transit points, **720** land border points and **186** sea border points. Of the **1,221** PoEs assessed, **1,014** (83%) have some form of restriction placed upon them, **468** were being fully closed for entry and exit and **401** partially closed. Of the assessed PoE's, **91%** were reported to be official points of entry. The most commonly imposed restriction period spanned between **14 days to one month** (57% of all PoEs). Of the **501** PoE's imposing some form of health restriction, **44%** are reportedly conducting routine health screenings, and a further **24%** have COVID-19 specific screening activities ongoing.

This information is collected through IOM offices and networks and all information presented is from the PoE Baseline database and is subject to change with time. Operational Status of Points of Entry (PoE)






Operational Status of Points of Entry (PoE) by classification



Type of Restrictions / Measures Imposed (Multi-choices question)




Type of Medical Measures in place (Multi-choices question)




Points of Entry Operational Status by classification and country & areas

 ■ Unknown



Description and Objective: The current outbreak of COVID-19 has affected global mobility in the form of various travel disruptions, restrictions and blockages. To better understand how COVID-19 affects global mobility, DTM is developing a global mobility database mapping the locations, status and different restrictions of Points of Entry (PoE), globally. These include airports, land border crossing points, sea border crossing points, internal transit points and areas of interest. This information is meant to serve IOM member states, IOM and its UN partner agencies, as well as voluntary partner agencies in responding adequately and in a target manner to the current crisis and to the eventual transition to a regular operation mode once the acute phase of the corona virus crisis is over. The information gathered should especially be useful to help States, the UN and other stakeholder to address specific needs faced by migrants and mobile populations during the crisis affected by the global mobility restrictions. To better understand the types and complexity of mobility restrictions being put in place, the DTM has developed the following methodology.

Methodology: DTM utilizes in-country expertise of IOM offices around the world to collect relevant information in a systematic and structured approach. Data is collected for following observation points:

- Points of entry and exit (airports, land borders and seaport)
- Transit points (in country locations on crossroads between cities and regions)
- Areas (regions or cities in the country)

For each of the observation point data is collected on:

- Type of restriction,
- Measures applied and time,
- Population category that might be affected from the measures.
