1,340 Chadian students stranded in Koutéré, while heading to Cameroon

Temperature screenings. People with high body temperatures are quarantined

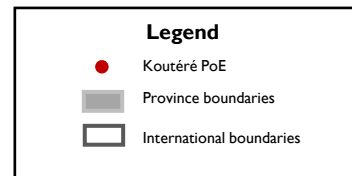
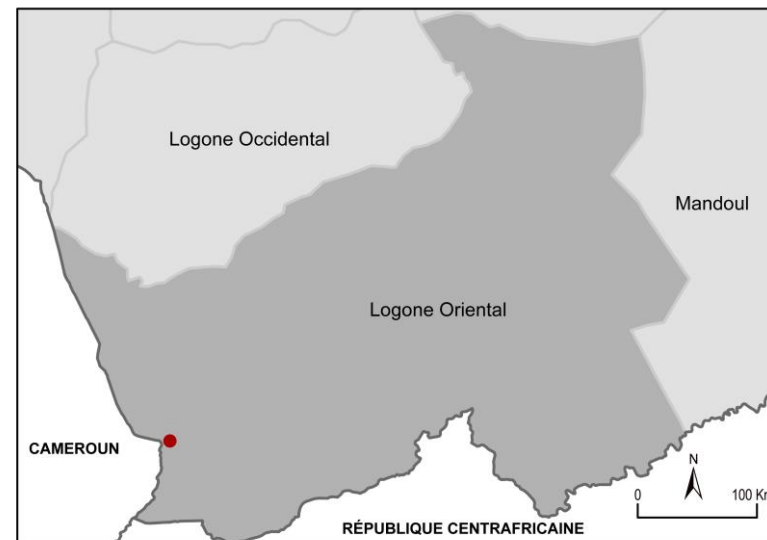

While heading to Cameroon, 1,340 Chadian students have been stranded at the Koutéré PoE due to Cameroonian authorities restrictions.

Key informants reported that following the easing of COVID-19 restrictions in Cameroon, universities reopened on 01 June 2020. However, entry into Cameroon continues to be restricted. Consequently, Cameroonian authorities have not allowed the students to cross the border.

The group stranded in Koutéré are students in Cameroon and returned to Chad when the universities were closed as a result of measures taken by the Cameroonian authorities to limit the spread of COVID-19. The majority of them were quarantined for 14 days when they arrived in Chad.

There are reports that a number of students currently staying in N'Djamena are planning to travel to Cameroon, through Koutéré, in order to resume studies. The number presented in this report was collected on 04 June 2020 and might evolve quickly.
