


Flow Monitoring Points | Migrant Arrivals and Yemeni Returns in June 2020




The International Organization for Migration (IOM) Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) monitors key migrant arrival and Yemen's northern border with the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) and southern coastal border. Enumerators placed at Flow Monitoring Points FMPs) record arrivals of migrants and Yemeni nationals' returns in order to identify different patterns and types of migrants entering the country. Access constraints limit the ability to collect data at some migrant) arrival points. IOM estimates that 749 migrants entered Yemen in addition to 259 Yemeni returns from Djibouti during June 2020 bringing the number of migrants who have arrived in Yemen in 2020 to 31,617 and the number of Yemeni returnees from KSA to 13,054 and from Djibouti to 259
