Assessment conducted in affected areas



The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to collect information on large and sudden population movements. Information is collected through key informant interviews or direct observation. This dashboard presents information on movements which took place on 21 July 2020 in the town of Ounianga Kébir, located in Ennedi-Ouest Province, near the Libyan border.

## **SUMMARY OF EVENT**



### AFFECTED POPULATION: 34 individuals

Following their deportation from Libya, 34 Chadian nationals (including 10 women and 2 girls) arrived in the town of Ounianga Kébir (Ennedi-Ouest Province) on 21 July 2020. Upon arrival, they were placed in quarantine, in accordance with the measures taken by the Chadian authorities to prevent and contain the spread of COVID-19. It should be noted that 57 individuals are already quarantined at this location, in a collective centre (see ETT report #60). In addition, the 69 individuals who had arrived on 5 July 2020 (see ETT report #58) have completed their 14-day quarantine period. Thus, in total, 91 individuals (including 3 Nigerian nationals and 2 Nigerien nationals) are currently in quarantine in Ounianga Kébir. It should be noted that since mid-April 2020, deportation movements have been observed from Libya to the city of Ounianga Kébir, where the deported persons arrive in a situation of extreme vulnerability.


