

### DISPLACEMENT TRACKING

DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects and reports on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs. In the first seven months of 2020, conflict and natural disasters have resulted in new patterns of displacement, particularly in Marib, Al Hudaydah, Al Dhale'e, and Taizz governorates.

### WEEKLY UPDATE

Between 2 and 8 August, newly displaced households were recorded in Al Hudaydah (567 HH), Taizz (12 HH), and Al Dhale'e (12 HH). Most of these displacements were the result of floods and heavy rains in Al Hudaydah (568 HH), and because of conflict in Aden (10 HH) and Al Dhale'e (10 HH).

### IDP HH WHO LEFT DISPLACED LOCATIONS

18 IDP households left their location of displacement and moved either to their place of origin or to some other displaced location.
