


Flow Monitoring Points | Migrant Arrivals and Yemeni Returns in August 2020



The International Organization for Migration (IOM) Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) monitors key migrant arrival and Yemeni return locations on Yemen's northern border with the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) and southern coastal border. Enumerators placed at Flow Monitoring Points (FMPs) record arrivals of migrants and Yemeni nationals' returns in order to identify different patterns and types of migrants entering the country. Access constraints limit the ability to collect data at some migrant arrival points. IOM estimates that 316 migrants entered Yemen and no Yemeni returns from KSA or from Horn of Africa during August 2020. Since beginning of 2020 till 31 Aug 2020, 32,505 individual migrants arrived in Yemen, and 13,417 Yemenis returns from KSA while another 266 Yemenis returns from Horn of Africa.
