DISPLACEMENT TRACKING

DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects and reports on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs. In the first eight months of 2020, conflict and natural disasters resulted in new patterns of displacement, particularly in Marib, Al Hudaydah, Al Dhale'e, Taizz and Al Jawf governorates.

WEEKLY UPDATE

Between 8 and 14 November, newly displaced households were recorded in Marib (162 HH), Taizz (82 HH), and Al Hudaydah (13 HH). Most of these displacements were the result of increased fighting in Marib (160 HH), Taizz (52 HH) and Al Hudaydah (26


Since the beginning of 2020, DTM 1.312 also identified other previously displaced households who left the displaced location and moved to either their place of origion or some other displaced location.
