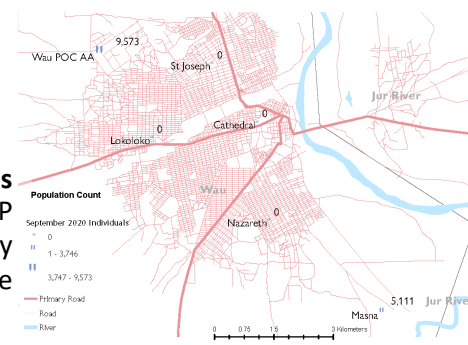


POPULATION COUNT:

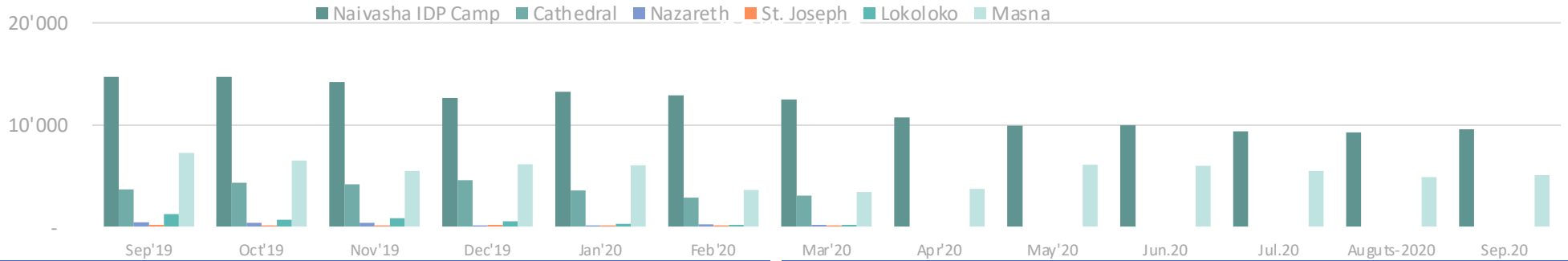
Naivasha IDP Camp (former Wau PoC AA) & Masna Collective Centre

Data collection September 2020

In September 2020, the monthly population count was conducted at **Masna collective centre where 5,111 individuals/825 households** were identified and **Naivasha IDP Camp (former Wau PoC AA) with 9,573 individuals/2,694 households**. The population of Naivasha IDP Camp increased from 9,295 individuals in August 2020 (increased by 278 individuals). Wau Masna saw an increase in its population by 186 individuals since August 2020. 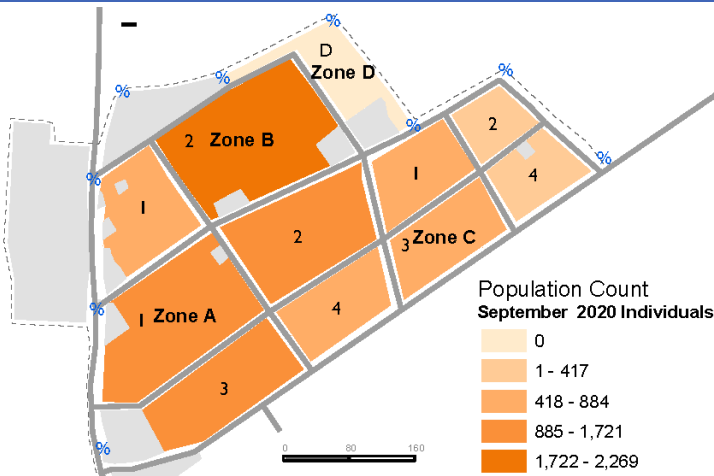


Monthly trend in Wau collective centres, September 2019 – September 2020



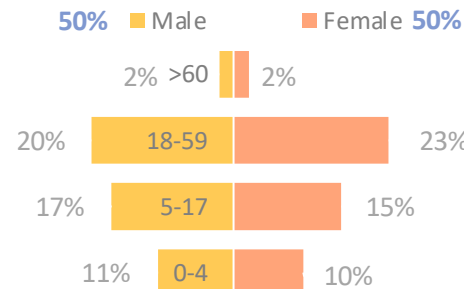
Population by zone and block, Naivasha IDP Camp (September 2020)

- 0% Zone D

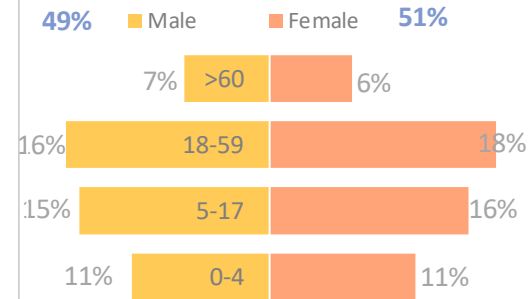


Naivasha IDP Camp & Masna Collective Centre by age and sex (September 2020)

Methodology

Since biometric registrations or verifications are not feasible on a monthly basis, population counts remain the best possible tool to estimate the sites' populations. Population counts consist of DTM teams visiting each shelter of the site asking how many persons have slept there the previous night (sex and age disaggregated). This provides a snapshot of the population at the time of the count.
