Guma: IDP population Increase due to influx from Mbabai, Uvir Mbadwem wards as a result of banditary attacks.

Batsari: IDP population Increase due to influx from differnt ward in the same LGA as a result of banditary attacks.


Reasons for Decrease





Barikin Ladi: IDP population decrease due to the close down of two sites (Ban and Kworos) in the LGA as they all reutured to their place of origin.

Goronyo: IDP population decrease due to the IDPs returning to their place of origin as a result of improved security.
