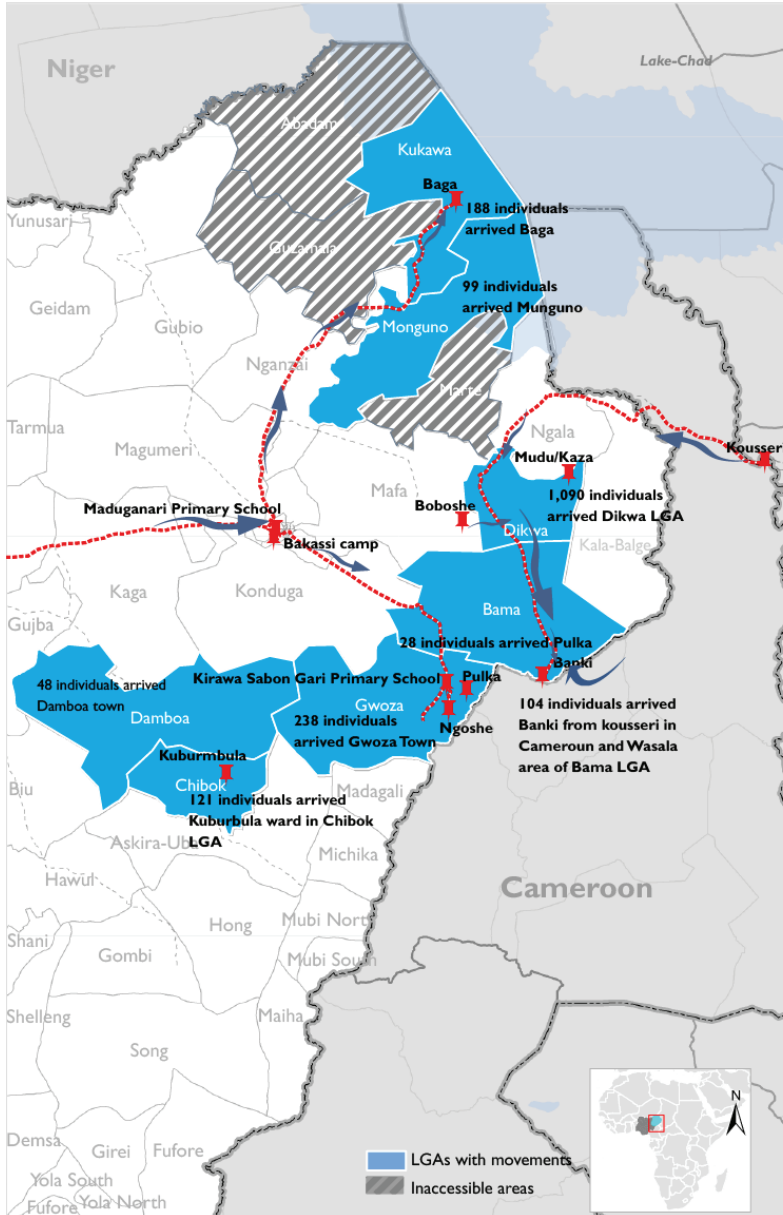

Reporting period: 3 - 8 May, 2017



SNAPSHOT: Bama, Chibok, Damboa, Dikwa, Gwoza, Kukawa and Monguno			
<p>LGA: Dikwa 6 - 8 May, 2017</p> <p>Location: Dikwa town</p> <p>Movement: Organized</p> <p>690 individuals (198 HH) arrived at Dikwa town from villages in Boboshe and Mudu/Kaza wards in Dikwa LGA. They were brought by the military on the evening of 6 May. Another 400 individuals arrived at 20-Housing Estate in Dikwa on 8 May.</p> <p>Trigger: Military operations</p> <p>Urgent need: Shelter</p> <p>DTM & ETT Cumulative: IDPs = 99,755</p>	<p>LGA: Monguno 3 May, 2017</p> <p>Location: GGSS Monguno</p> <p>Movement: Organized</p> <p>99 individuals (43 HH) were brought by the military to GGSS Monguno on 4 May. They were rescued by the military in Goniri Mauuli area of Marte LGA</p> <p>Trigger: Military operations (Routine patrol)</p> <p>Needs: Food, shelter, NFI and water</p> <p>DTM & ETT Cumulative: IDPs = 121,781</p>	<p>LGA: Gwoza 5 - 6 May, 2017</p> <p>Location: Gwoza town</p> <p>Movement: Organized</p> <p>238 individuals (63 HH) returned to Gwoza from Mairi Kuwait, Maduganari and Bakassi camp of MMC and Jere LGAs, respectively.</p> <p>Trigger: Improved security</p> <p>Urgent needs: Shelter and food</p> <p>DTM & ETT Cumulative: IDPs = 60,270</p>	<p>LGA: Gwoza 5 - 6 May, 2017</p> <p>Location: Pulka</p> <p>Movement: Spontaneous</p> <p>28 individuals (9 HH) arrived at Pulka from Baldagahulda, Sabon Gari and other part of Ngoshe axis.</p> <p>Trigger: Military operations</p> <p>Needs: Food, shelter, and water</p> <p>DTM & ETT Cumulative: IDPs = 60,270</p>
<p>LGA: Bama 3 - 7 May, 2017</p> <p>Location: Banki</p> <p>Movement: Spontaneous</p> <p>104 individuals (25 HH) arrived in Banki from Kousseri in Cameroon and Wasala area of Borno's Bama LGA. Most of them have been provided with the basic humanitarian assistance.</p> <p>Trigger: Military operations</p> <p>Available Services: Shelter, food, water, health and protection</p> <p>DTM & ETT Cumulative: IDPs = 40,364</p>	<p>LGA: Chibok 3 - 7 May, 2017</p> <p>Location Type: Kuburbula ward</p> <p>Movement: Spontaneous</p> <p>121 individuals (33HH) came in to Kuburbula in Chibok from Mifa and Kwamtiyahi wards in Chibok LGA, in search of better living conditions.</p> <p>Trigger: Poor living condition</p> <p>Need: Shelter</p> <p>DTM & ETT Cumulative: IDPs = 12,878</p>	<p>LGA: Kukawa 3 - 7 May, 2017</p> <p>Location: Baga</p> <p>Movement: Spontaneous</p> <p>188 individuals (99 HH) came into Baga from Kukawa, Hadeja in Bauchi State and Gwange-2, respectively. They spread across Baga and Doro/Dugum area of Kukawa LGA.</p> <p>Trigger: Voluntary relocation</p> <p>Needs: Food, Shelter and NFI</p> <p>DTM & ETT Cumulative: IDPs = 16,915</p>	<p>LGA: Damboa 3 - 7 May, 2017</p> <p>Location: Damboa town</p> <p>Movement: Spontaneous</p> <p>48 individuals (18 HH) arrived in Damboa town from Mulgwai, Sabon Gari and other axis of the same Damboa LGA</p> <p>Trigger: Fear of attack</p> <p>Needs: Food and Shelter</p> <p>DTM & ETT Cumulative: IDPs = 56,668</p>
