

<h3>DISPLACEMENT TRACKING</h3> <p>DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects and reports on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs.</p>	<h3>WEEKLY UPDATE</h3> <p>Between 17 and 23 January, newly displaced households were recorded in Taizz (47 HH), Al Dhale'e (44 HH), and Marib (20 HH). Most of these displacements were the result of increased fighting in Al Dhale'e (32 HH), Taizz (30 HH) and Al Hudaydah (16 HH).</p>	<h3>IDP HH WHO LEFT DISPLACED LOCATIONS</h3> <p>Since the beginning of 2021, DTM also identified other 2 previously displaced households who left the displaced location and moved to either their place of origin or some other displaced location.</p>
