


From 6 to 7 February 2021, in close coordination with the Mozambique's National Institute for Disaster Management and Risk Reduction (INGD), International Organization for Migration (IOM) DTM, and the CCCM Cluster together with the Protection Clusters (including Child Protection AOR), the Local HCT and the Ministry of Education conducted an intention survey, at household level, in accommodation centres located in Beira district of Sofala province. A total of 593 heads of households (accounting for 2,762 family members) were interviewed during this exercise to understand their intentions and concerns.

The findings from the 593 households were used as a basis to generalise to a population of approximately 11,108 individuals staying in the accommodation centres in Beira city. The margin of error on reported findings is 14.1 percentage points with a 90 per cent level of confidence.


### DATE OF DEPARTURE FROM AREAS OF ORIGIN

The majority of families (82%) in the accommodation centres left their area of origin post Tropical Cyclone Eloise and the remaining 18 per cent departed post Tropical Storm Chalane.



### RESIDENCE PRIOR TO DISPLACEMENT


Sixty-seven per cent of all IDP households had been living in their own house prior to evacuation, while 26 per cent had been living in rented houses and seven per cent had been residing with family members or friends

### DEMOGRAPHY PROFILES OF HOUSEHOLDS INTERVIEWED

Children make 58 per cent of the composition of the households, while 26 per cent are women and 16 per cent are men. Among the surveyed households, different vulnerable categories have been reported: 94 elderly people (3% of the total number of family members surveyed), and 133 persons with vulnerabilities (5%).




Percentage of population by sex and age group

Percentage of population by age group


### HOUSING STATUS OF RESPONDANTS

The majority (95%) of the households reported having their houses affected - destroyed, severely or partially damaged, while three per cent still have their house flooded and two per cent of the houses had been looted.




Current state of house in which families had lived prior to displacement

### RETURN INTENTION





The majority (66%) of households indicated their intention to return to their place of origin. While another 13 per cent had not decided yet, pending information and support. Further interviews and discussions took place on the second day of the survey in Samora Machel, Nharimue, Matadouro, Ifapa, Escola de Ensino Especial 3, and 12 de Outubro centres, where initial feedback was provided regarding intention to move to another place and unsuitable return conditions. In those sites, the majority 61 per cent said they wanted to return to their place of origin, 36 per cent want to relocate to another place and the remaining two per cent want to either remain or have not decided.
