

### DISPLACEMENT TRACKING

DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects and reports on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs.

### WEEKLY UPDATE

Between 7 and 13 February, newly displaced households were recorded in Marib (512 HH), Al Dhale'e (51 HH), and Taizz (38 HH). Most of these displacements were the result of increased fighting in Marib (461 HH), Sana'a (62 HH) and Al Dhale'e (38 HH).

### IDP HH WHO LEFT DISPLACED LOCATIONS

Since the beginning of 2021, DTM also identified other 17 previously displaced households who left the displaced location and moved to either their place of origin or some other displaced location.
