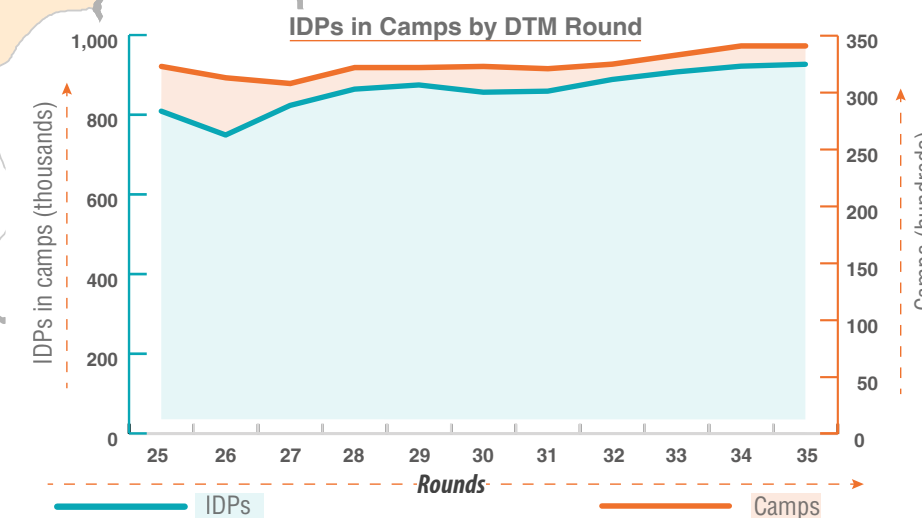
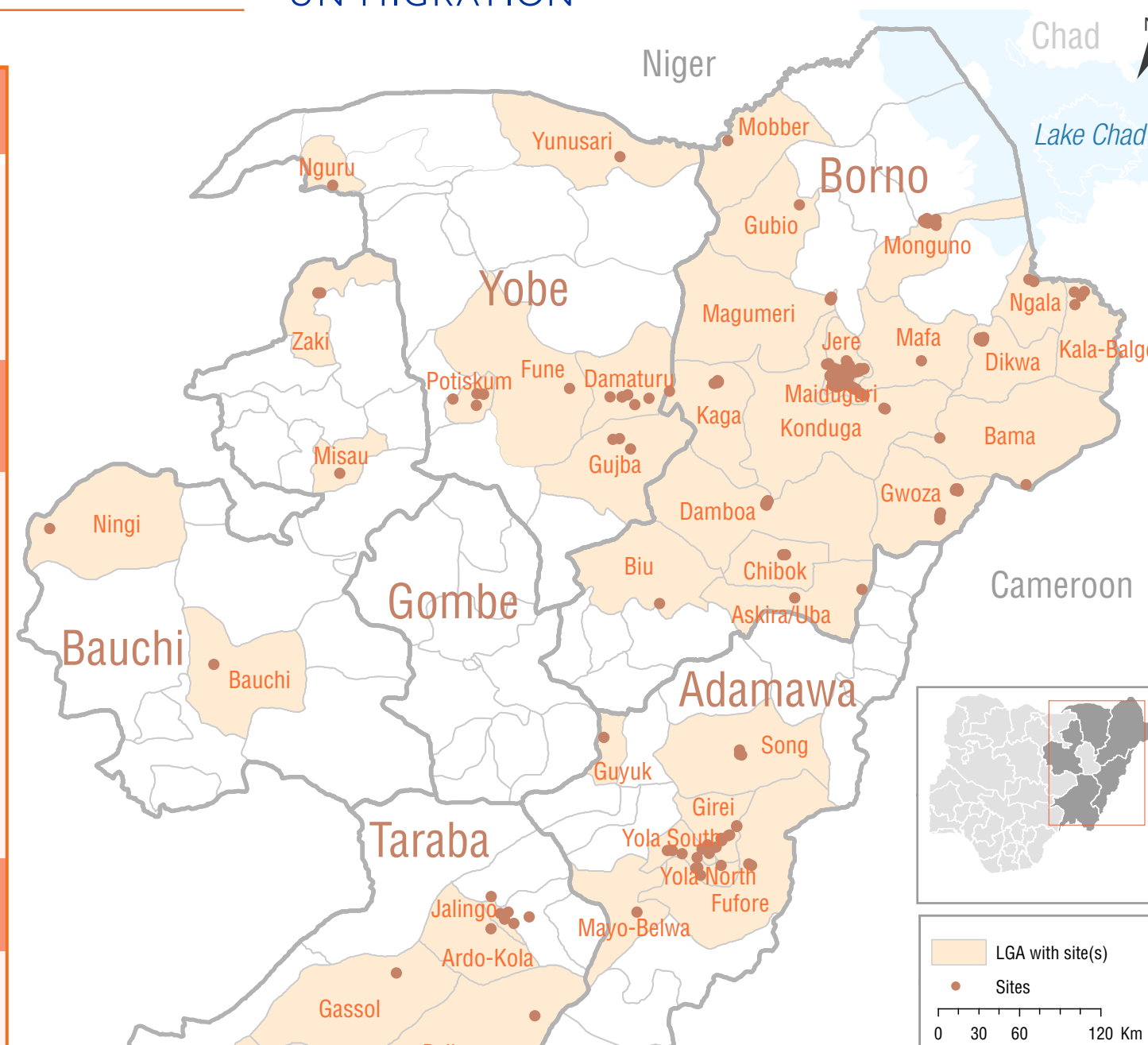


In camps/camp-like settings:

- 81%** of IDPs are women and children.
- 23%** of IDPs are children under 5 years.
- 55%** of IDPs are female.
- 45%** of IDPs are male.
- 7%** of IDPs are nursing mothers.
- 42%** of IDPs have been previously displaced.
- 65%** of IDPs cited tarpaulin as the most needed shelter material.
- 5%** of the sites do not have any means of shelter.
- 4%** of IDPs complained of not having potable water.
- 51%** of IDPs cited blanket/mat as the most needed NFI.
- 2%** of children do not have access to education services.
- 63%** of education facilities are located off-sites.
- 63%** of IDPs cited malaria as the most common health problem.
- 12%** of IDPs do not have access to regular medicine.
- 21%** of IDPs do not have access to food support.
- In **89%** of the sites surveyed, IDPs cited food as the main unmet need.
