

### DISPLACEMENT TRACKING

DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects and reports on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs.

### WEEKLY UPDATE

Between 28 March and 3 April, newly displaced households were recorded in Marib (429 HH), Taizz (77 HH), and Al Dhale'e (45 HH). Most of these displacements were the result of increased fighting in Marib (435 HH), Taizz (77 HH) and Al Hudaydah (37 HH).

### IDP HH WHO LEFT DISPLACED LOCATIONS

Since the beginning of 2021, DTM also identified other 450 previously displaced households who left the displaced location and moved to either their place of origin or some other displaced location.
