# **DTM** RAPID DISPLACEMENT TRACKING

## YEMEN IDP DASHBOARD | REPORTING PERIOD: 18 APRIL 2021 TO 24 APRIL 2021







IOM Yemen DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects and reports on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs. It also tracks Returnees and IDPs who Left the Location of displacement to a different displacement location.

From 01 January 2021 to 24 April 2021, IOM Yemen DTM estimates that 5,068 households (HH) (30,408 Individuals) have experienced displacement at least once. Between 18 April 2021 and 24 April 2021, IOM Yemen DTM tracked 101 households (606 individuals) displaced at least once.

UPDATE: An additional 11 HHs were displaced between 11 April and 17 April 2021 and have been added to the total households.

Since the beginning of 2021, DTM also identified 460 previously displaced households who left the displaced location and moved to either their place of origin or some other displaced location.




