In camps/camp-like settings:

26% of IDPs are women. **19%** of IDPs are men.

30% of IDPs are girls. **25%** of IDPs are boys.

22% of IDPs are children under 5 years. **7%** of IDPs are nursing mothers.

45% of IDPs have been previously displaced. **68%** of IDPs cited tarpaulin as the most needed shelter material.

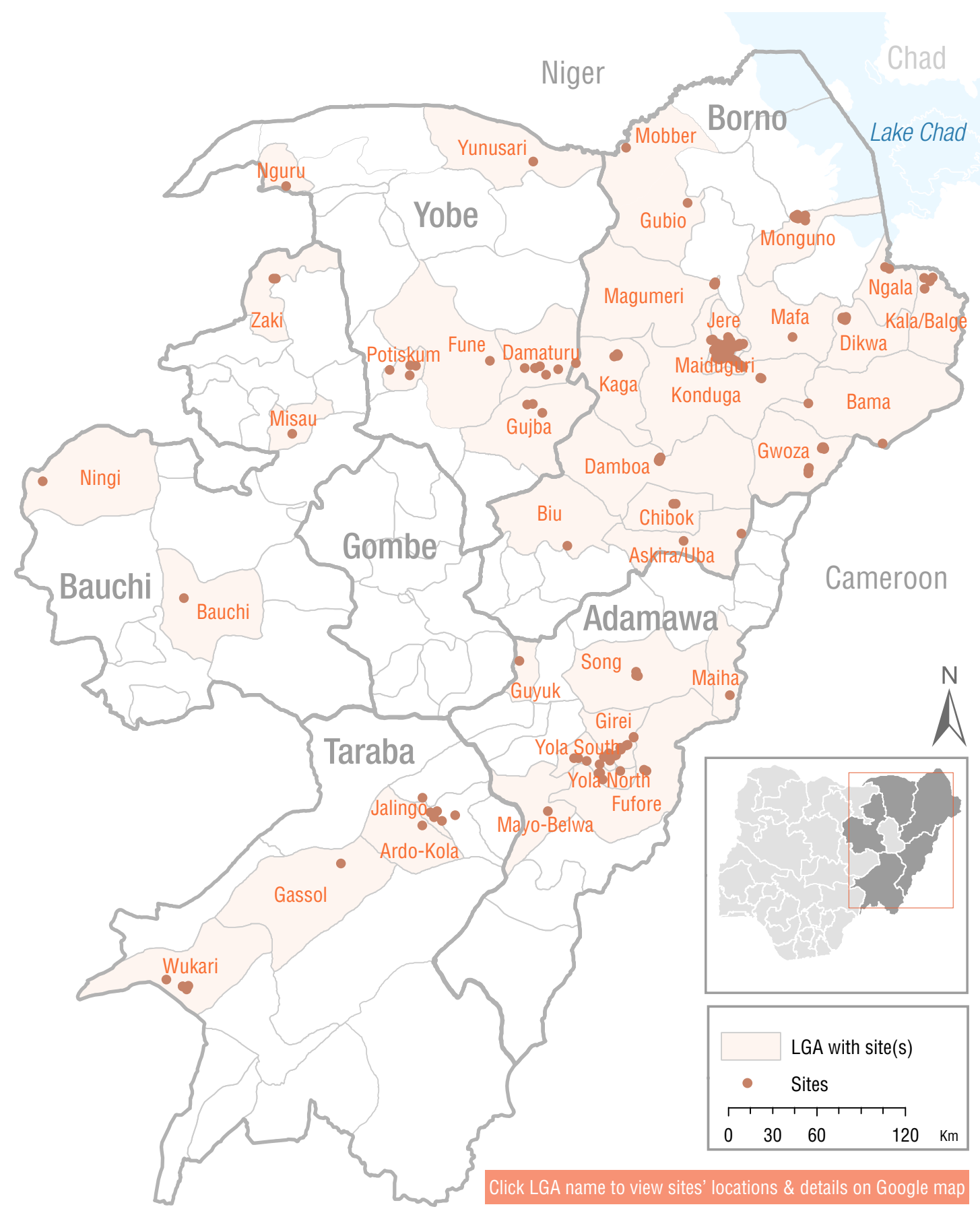
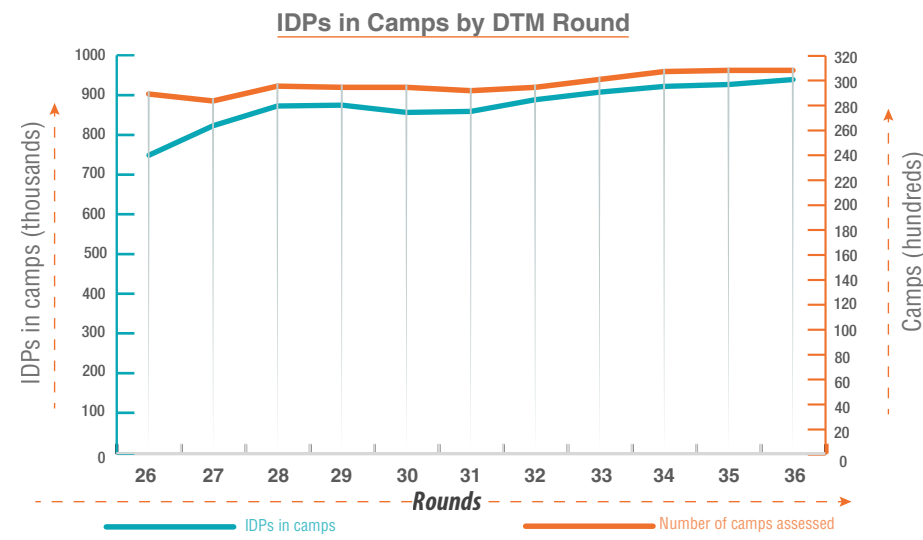
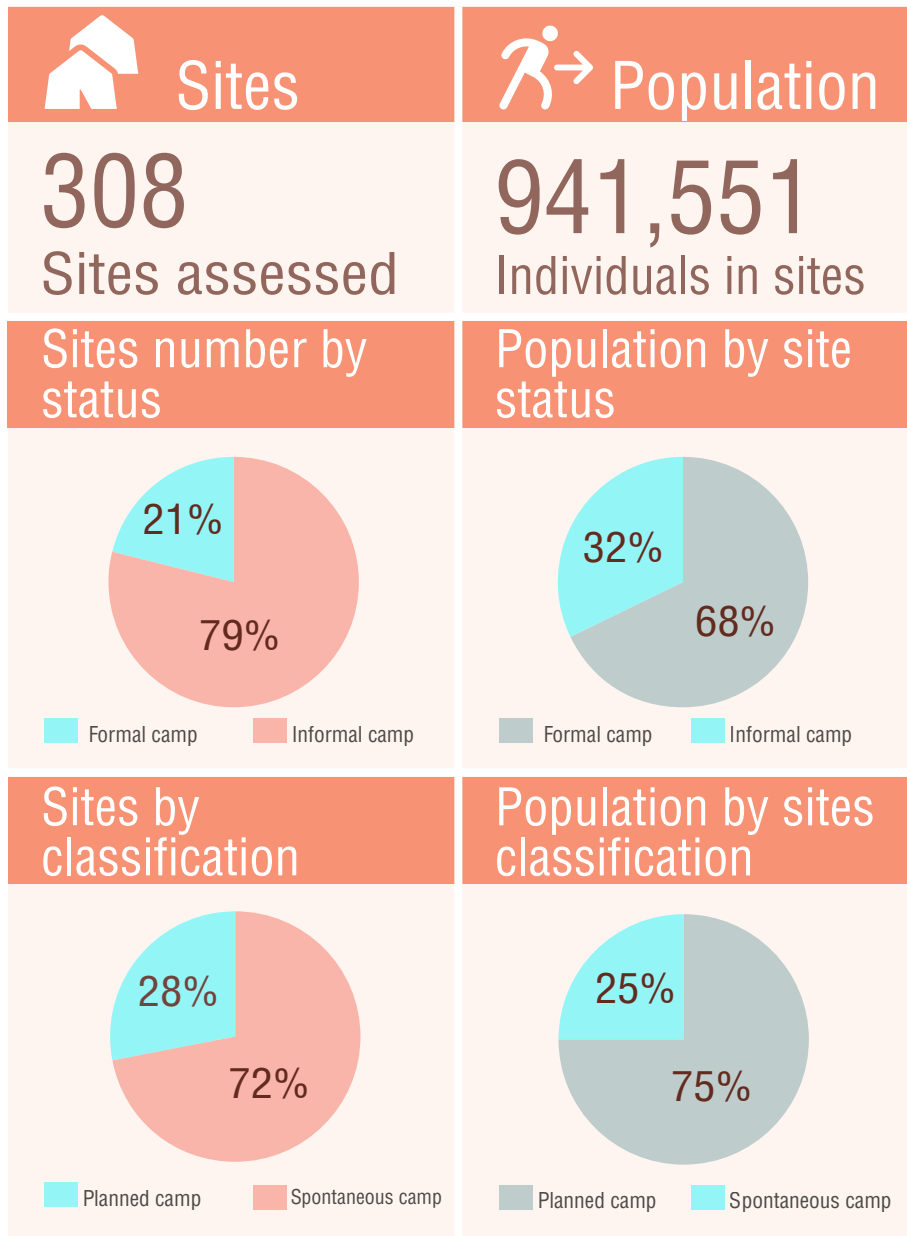
5% of IDPs complained of not having potable water. **56%** of IDPs cited blanket/mat as the most needed NFI.

56% of education facilities are located off-sites.

59% of IDPs cited malaria as the most common health problem.

14% of IDPs do not have access to regular medicine.

20% of IDPs do not have access to food support.
In **86%** of the sites surveyed, IDPs cited food as the main unmet need.
