
OVERVIEW

In April 2021, a total of 18,166 movements were observed across Ethiopia's five flow monitoring points (FMPs). This represents a 3% decrease in daily average movement in comparison with March 2021 when an average of 627 movements per day were observed. It should be noted that data collection at Humera Flow Monitoring Point in Tigray region is not taking place due to security and access constraints, MOVEMENT ILLUSTRATION thus affecting the total number of movements for the month.

Despite the slight decrease in movements this month, outgoing movements during March have continued to be significantly higher (78.8%) than incoming movements (21.2%). The percentage of outgoing versus incoming movements have continued to climb above the proportions observed before the first COVID-19 case was confirmed in Ethiopia. A total of 14,313 outgoing movements were observed of which 7,003 (48.9%) were going towards the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, 1,904 (13.3%) travelling towards Djibouti, 1,806 (12.6%) were going to Kenya, 774 (5.4%) to Somalia, 690 (4.8%) to South Africa, 475 (3.3%) intended to United Arab Emirates and 375 (2.6%) head to Yemen.

At the same time 3,853 incoming movements were observed, of which 2,481 (64.4%) had originated from Sudan, while 632 (16.4%) and 600 (15.6%) came from Djibouti and Kenya respectively. Almost all of these were Ethiopian nationals who were likely returning home. The Morocco number of incoming movements into Ethiopia from Sudan has increased since the outbreak of the Northern Ethiopia Crisis from 2,022 inflows movements in December 2020, to 2,643 inflow movements in January, to 2,662 inflows in Februay, 2,978 inflows in March and 2,481 inflow movements in April 2021.




