TOTAL NUMBER OF IDPS CURRENTLY DISPLACED






On 14 January:

- Nargizlia1 Camp received approximately 20 families from Merkaz Tilkaif and Merkaz Mosul sub-districts;
- Approximately 56 families from Merkaz Mosul sub-district reached Haj Ali camp;
- The increase of 430 IDP families in Qayyarah Airstrip emergency site is not due to new arrivals. The number of families who were still waiting for a plot to be allocated has been included in the total number of IDPs in the emergency site.

*Emergency tracking numbers are not cumulative. They reflect a snapshot of displacement on the day of reporting. The number of individuals is calculated by multiplying the number of identified families by six, which is the average size of an Iraqi family.
