### MOSUL OPERATIONS DATA SNAPSHOT: 29 JANUARY 2017

The Emergency Tracking (ET) system is a crisis-based tool that aims at tracking sudden displacement or return movements triggered by specific crises. The ET figures reported on this portal are not cumulative of the all persons affected by the Mosul crisis thus far, rather

the ET update provides only a snapshot of the current displacement situation for the indicated date. The data and information reported on this page are related solely to the displacement caused by the Mosul operations which started on 17 October 2016.




#### WHERE ARE PEOPLE COMING FROM?

Number of individuals displaced, by district of origin




#### WHERE ARE PEOPLE STAYING?

#### On 25 January:

- Nargizlia1 Camp received 47 families from Merkaz Tilkaif and Merkaz Mosul sub-districts;
- Approximately 137 families from Altal sub-district (Hatra district) and Markaz Mosul sub-district were displaced to Jawa'na (Qayyarah sub-district);
- Approximately 15 families arrived to Qayyarah Airstrip emergency site, while 1 family left;
- Approximately 13 families arrived to Qayyarah Jad'ah 3 camp, while 4 families left;
- Approximately 4 families arrived to Qayyarah Jad'ah 2 camp, while 3 families left;
- Approximately 3 families arrived to Qayyarah Jad'ah 1 camp;
- Approximately 30 families reached Khazer M1 camp;
- Approximately 25 families reached Hasansham M2 (former Khazer M2) camp from Merkaz Tilkaif sub-district, while 100 families left;
- Approximately 5 families entered Hasansham U3 camp, while 40 families left.

\*Emergency tracking numbers are not cumulative. They reflect a snapshot of displacement on the day of reporting. The number of individuals is calculated by multiplying the number of identified families by six, which is the average size of an Iraqi family.

The IOM Iraq Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) is the standard data source being used in Iraq to guide the humanitarian response. Emergency tracking for the Mosul operations began identifying people displaced resulting from military actions that began on 17 October.
