








IOM Yemen DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects data on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis from their locations of origin or displacement, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs. It also tracks Returnees who returned to their location of origin.

During the reporting period, between 20 and 26 June 2021, IOM Yemen DTM tracked 221 households (1,326 individuals) displaced at least once. From 01 January to 26 June 2021, IOM Yemen DTM estimates that 6,555 households (HH) (39,330 Individuals) have experienced displacement at least once.

Some 42 HH were displaced in the previous reporting period, which covered 13 - 19 June 2021. However, they were only identified in the current period and so, this figure has been added to the cumulative
