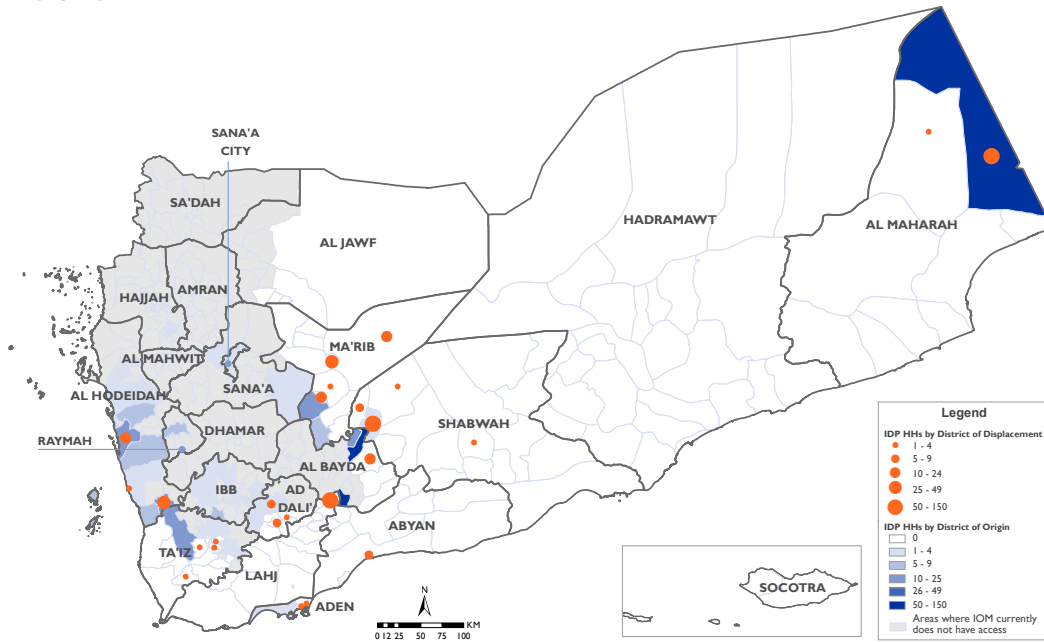
IOM Yemen DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects data on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis from their locations of origin or displacement, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, causes of displacement, geography and needs. It also tracks Returnees who returned to their location of origin.

During the reporting period, between 25 and 31 July 2021, IOM Yemen DTM tracked 457 households (HH) (2,742 individuals) displaced at least once. Conflict was the main reason for displacement, accounting for 87 per cent (395 HH) of the total, followed by natural disaster, accounting for 12 per cent (56 HH) and other causes, accounting for one per cent (6 HH). From 01 January to 31 July 2021, IOM Yemen DTM estimates that 8,205 households (49,230 Individuals) have experienced displacement at least once.

Some 47 HH were displaced in the previous reporting period, which covered 18 to 24 July 2021. However, they were only identified in the current period and so, this figure has been added to the cumulative displacement total recorded from the beginning of the year.

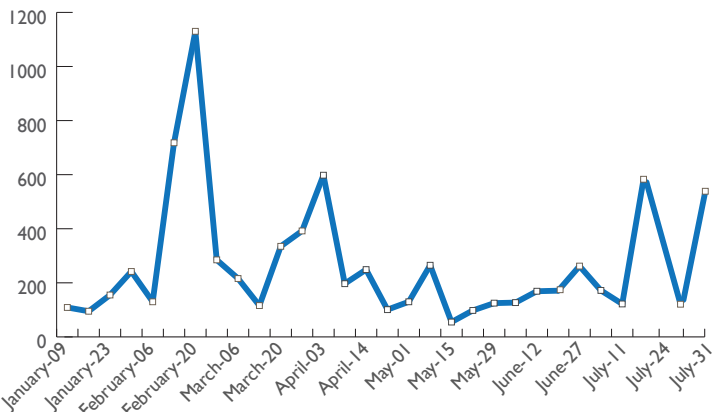
