Assessment conducted in affected areas





The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to collect information on large and sudden population movements. Information is collected through key informant interviews or direct observation. This dashboard provides information on displacement which occurred on 1 September 2021 in a village in the Lac Province.

SUMMARY OF EVENT



DISPLACED POPULATION:

137 Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs), 46 Households (estimated)

On 1 September 2021, due to increasing insecurity in the Lake Province (due an increasing number of attacks by non-state armed groups) and rising water levels, 46 households (137 individuals) preventively left the village of Kanguela (sous-préfecture of Bol, département of Mamdi), located in the islands of Lake Chad, to take refuge in the village of Medi-Koura located on the mainland (within the same sous-préfecture).
