In camps/camp-like settings:

- 26%** of IDPs are women.
- 19%** of IDPs are men.
- 30%** of IDPs are girls.
- 25%** of IDPs are boys.
- 22%** of IDPs are children under 5 years.
- 7%** of IDPs are nursing mothers.
- 45%** of IDPs have been previously displaced.
- 67%** of IDPs cited tarpaulin as the most needed shelter material.
- 4%** of IDPs complained of not having potable water.
- 54%** of IDPs cited blanket/mat as the most needed NFI.
- 67%** of education facilities are located off-sites.
- 61%** of IDPs cited malaria as the most common health problem.
- 12%** of IDPs do not have access to regular medication.
- 19%** of IDPs do not have access to food support.
- In **90%** of the sites surveyed, IDPs cited food as the main unmet need.
