



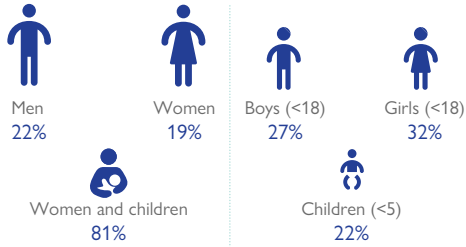

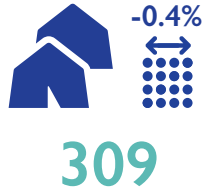
Demographic composition:



In camps/camp-like settings:

- 43% of IDPs have been previously displaced.
- 68% of IDPs cited tarpaulin as the most needed shelter material.
- 4% of IDPs complained of not having potable water.
- 47% of IDPs cited blanket/mat as the most needed NFI.
- 64% of education facilities are located off-sites.
- 65% of IDPs cited malaria as the most common health problem.
- 13% of IDPs do not have access to regular medication.
- 21% of IDPs do not have access to food support. In 86% of the sites surveyed, IDPs cited food as the main unmet need.

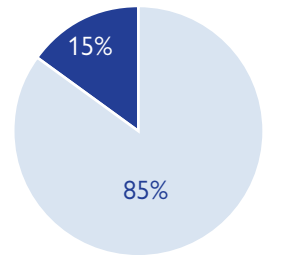

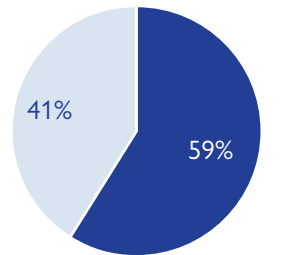
IDP in camps/camp-like settings



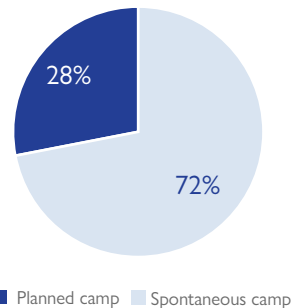
Sites number by status



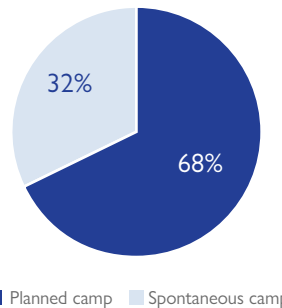
Population by site status



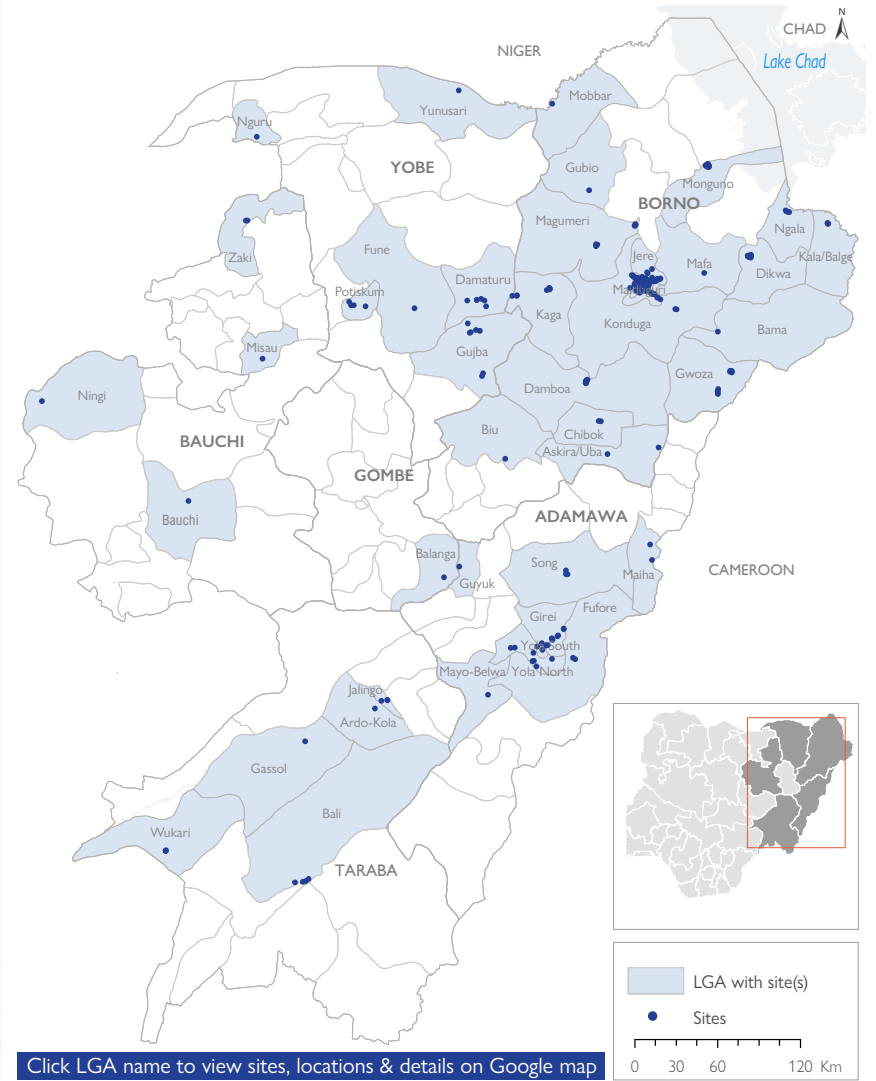
Sites by classification
