

SUMMARY OF EVENT



DISPLACED POPULATION:

1033 Internally Displaced Persons, **247** Households (estimation)

On 13 January 2022, following an attack carried out by Non-State Armed Groups (NSAGs) in the site of Massakani (sous-prefecture of Liwa) on the night of 12 January, 247 households (1,033 individuals) of IDPs left the Massakani site and fled to the newly established site, called Merème, located near the site of Amma, in the same sousprefecture.

REASON FOR MOVEMENT: Armed attack



DATE OF MOVEMENT: 13 January 2022


