

# FLASH REPORT - TROPICAL STORM GOMBE

IOM/INGD 72 Hours Aftermath Rapid Assessment

Damages recorded in the communities assessed so far - Nampula and Zambezia Provinces

## OVERVIEW<sup>2</sup>

Tropical Storm Gombe made landfall as a Category 3 Tropical Cyclone on Friday, March 11 at 00:00 GMT on the coast between Mossuril and Mogincual districts (Nampula Province). Further reports of damages have been recorded in Nampula and Zambizia provinces. Situational overviews across affected provinces report at least 400,175 individuals affected, 82 people injured, 20 people killed as well infrastructure damages to 301 schools, 691 classrooms and 17 health centres (INGD, 15 March).

Through an existing network of enumerators on ground, IOM, in close coordination with INGD, has been providing logistical and technical support in rapid assessments within the first 72 hours of Tropical Storm Gombe landfall.

Within these assessments, a total of 56 Accommodation Centres have been assessed in order to provide a preliminary snapshot of displaced populations in Nampula and Zambezia provinces. Detailed, joint multi-sectoral needs assessments, led by INGD and in collaboration with humanitarian partners, are currently ongoing. IOM DTM teams continue to support in rapid assessments in Nampula and Zambezia – flagging locations, primary needs and impacts across communities yet to be evaluated through in-depth multisectoral assessments.

### RAPID ASSESSMENT

Following these events, rapid assessments were conducted by the International Organization for Migration (IOM) in collaboration with the National Institute for Disaster Management and Risk Reduction (INGD), from the 12 March 2022. Joint multi-sectoral assessments are still ongoing with focus on understanding the extent of damages to houses and facilities across all affected localities in Nampula and Zambezia Provinces.

As a result of the impact of Tropical Cyclone Gombe, an estimate of 77,279 families had their houses completely/partially destroyed in the districts assessed so far. Of these, 44,167 are located across Manapo, 7,000 in the district of Ilha de Moç, 1,411 in Murrupula, 684 in Rapale, 675 in Ribaue, 458 in Memba, 407 in Angoche and 17 in Mogovolas, in the province of Nampula; 970 are located across Quelimane, 701 in the district of Molumbo, 660 in Maganja da Costa, 545 in Nicoadala, 168 in Alto Molocue, 167 in Gile, 89 in Milange and 89 in Mocuba, 57 in Ile, 53 in Derre, 167 in Gile, 32 in Pebane, 14 in Inhassunge and 14 in Lugela in the province of Zambezia

In total, 74,952 permanent houses, tents and emergency shelters were completely or partially destroyed due to the rain and strong winds. Moreover, 301 schools in the localities assessed were completely or partially damaged. A total of 691 classrooms were completely or partilly damaged in the affected schools. 17 health centers were also completely/partially damaged


