

Afmadow district has experienced an IDP influx from Middle Juba, Lower Juba and Bay as a result of insecurity, natural disaster and search for humanitarian assistance. Most sites in the district are spontaneous, and unnamed. Key Informants (KIs) at the site level indicated receiving humanitarian assistance at the site level, however, there is variation on the level of services available. Food, shelter, water and sanitation are the priority needs.

In order to better understand the geographic distribution of displacement sites and population estimates, DTM rolled out the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT). Data collected through this tool will allow, partners to have the number of people currently residing in each displacement site in order to plan for service delivery. "Custom tables on service delivery are available upon request, and also available in the data-set".





