Weekly trends can fluctuate due to security conditions in the region, the political climate in Niger and neighbouring countries, presence of migrants at the flow monitoring points and availability of transport and opportunities. The previous two weeks constitute the highest flows of outgoing and incoming migrants recorded by the flow monitoring. The increase in migrants has mainly been through the flow monitoring point of Seguedine while Arlit has remained constant.




Nationality numbers presented can give indications of nationalities present but should not be taken as exact nationalities present in the flows. The current graphs allow for a visualisation of nationality fluctuations over time. Currently the data indicates high increase of Nigerians, Ivorians and Nigeriens in the outgoing flows while incoming flows continue to have a higher proportion of Nigeriens.


NIGER Flow Monitoring Points (FMP)

Flow monitoring points are placed at known migrant passing points along the Niger migratory route. Data is collected daily at FMPs to inform migrant movements and profiles. The data collected provides a snapshot of migrant movements through the region. The numbers are collected from primary sources and do not claim to reflect all migrants passing through the flow monitoring points.










Proportion of men and women in Séguédine flow


