



As of June 2022, the Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) in the East and Horn of Africa was active in **six** countries (Burundi, Djibouti, Ethiopia, Somalia, South Sudan and Uganda), and its methodology includes four main components (mobility tracking, flow monitoring, registrations and surveys).<sup>1</sup>

Mobility tracking activities were conducted in <u>Burundi</u> (with periodically internal displacement and emergency monitoring dashboards), <u>Ethiopia</u>, (Rounds <u>11</u> and <u>12</u> of the national displacement reports), <u>Somalia</u> (weekly emergency trend tracking reports in Gedo region), <u>South Sudan</u> (population count dashboards in Bentiu and Naivasha IDP camps and Masna collective centre) and <u>Uganda</u> (monthly multi-hazard response infographics nationwide).

Flow monitoring was operational in all countries, through a network of 45 flow monitoring points (FMPs), with the main aim of tracking cross-border movements trends in the region. FMPs established at key areas of high mobility monitor different kinds of movements, including movements along the four main migration routes (Eastern, Horn of Africa, Southern and Northern) and other shorter-term cross-border movements, mainly tracked in South Sudan.<sup>2</sup>

Total movements observed: **301,761** through **21** FMPs (**-6%** from 322,553 in |an-|un 2021)






Flow monitoring activities were suspended between March and June 2022 in Somalia, and between April and June 2022 in Burundi.








