

Summary

Askira/Uba (Triggers: poor living conditions, improved security, voluntary relocation): 114 new arrivals and 50 departures were recorded in Askira/Uba during the reporting period. These include 29 individuals (INDs) who arrived from Hawul LGA, 37 INDs who arrived from neighbouring wards of Askira/Uba, 6 INDs who arrived from Jere, 42 INDs who returned to the town from Adamawa State, 15 INDs who left the town for Gwoza LGA and 35 INDs who left the town for Madagali LGA in Adamawa.

Bama (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living conditions): 69 INDs arrived at Bama town and 174 INDs left Bama during the reporting period. These include 51 arrivals at Banki Camp, 18 arrivals at General Hospital Camp, 51 departures from General Hospital Camp and 123 departures from Banki Camp.

Chibok (Trigger: improved security): 32 INDs left Chibok for Kwamdi in Gumsuri ward of Damboa LGA.

Damboa (Trigger: poor living conditions): 12 INDs arrived at Damboa during the reporting period. These include 8 INDs who arrived at SSS Quarters Camp from Yerwa ward and 4 INDs who arrived at Damboa Central community from Mubi North in Adamawa.

Dikwa (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 20 INDs arrived at Dikwa 20-Housing Estate from Magarta and Muliye wards of Dikwa.

Gwoza (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living conditions): 507 INDs arrived at Gwoza during the reporting period. These include 86 new arrivals at Wege Arrival Centre in Pulka, 22 arrivals at Central Primary School Camp, 316 (returnees) arrivals at Gadamayo community and 83 (returnees) arrivals at Wakane community.

Konduga (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 23 INDs arrived and 21 INDs left Konduga during the reporting period. These include 15 arrivals at Boarding School Camp from Bama, 8 arrivals at Federal Training Center Camp from Damboa and 21 departures from 250-Housing Estate Camp for Kumshe/Nduguno in Bama LGA.

Kukawa (Triggers: improved security, poor living conditions): 292 INDs arrived at Kukawa town during the reporting period. These include 204 INDs who arrived at Junior Primary School Camp from Baga ward of Kukawa, 16 INDs who arrived from Maiduguri M.C. LGA, 9 INDs who arrived at the town from nearby Nyamaram village, 6 INDs who arrived from Mairi in Jere LGA, 10 INDs who arrived at the town from Bauchi State, 18 INDs who arrived from Kebbi State, 12 INDs who arrived from Jigawa State, 9 INDs who arrived from Sokoto State and 8 INDs who arrived from Kano State.

Madagali (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 32 INDs arrived and 30 INDs left Madagali town during the reporting period. These include 13 INDs who arrived at Gwajitai from Mubi South LGA, 19 INDs who arrived at Pallam A from Wagga ward of Madagali LGA, 23 INDs who left Dar B for Kirchinya in Madagali and 7 INDs who left Gublah for Mubi South LGA.

Mafa (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living conditions): 36 INDs arrived at Mafa during the reporting period. These include 18 new arrivals at Mafa Primary School Camp from neighbouring villages and 18 INDs who arrived from Jere (5 INDs), Mafa (4 INDs), Hong in Adamawa State (5 INDs) and Chanchaga in Niger State (4 INDs).

Michika (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living conditions): 57 INDs arrived at Michika and 17 INDs left Michika during the reporting period. These include 20 INDs who arrived from Madagali LGA, 11 INDs who arrived from Gombi LGA, 15 INDs who arrived from Akko in Gombe State, 11 INDs who arrived from Bwari in F.C.T (Abuja), and 17 INDs who left for Bakin Dutse in Madagali LGA.

Monguno (Triggers: Voluntary relocation, poor living conditions): 13 INDs arrived at Monguno during the reporting period. These include 8 INDs who arrived at Fulatari Camp from Maiduguri M.C. and 5 INDs who arrived at Bakassi community from Dass in Bauchi State.

Mubi-South (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 30 INDs arrived at Mubi-South and 62 INDs left Mubi-South during the reporting period. These include 23 arrivals from Minawawa in Cameroon, 7 arrivals from Gubla in Madagali LGA, 56 INDs who left for Gwoza in Borno State and 6 INDs who left Mubi Burnt Bricks Factory Camp for neighbouring Larmode Community.

Ngala (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 113 INDs arrived at International School Camp Ngala during the reporting period. These include 104 INDs who arrived from Gamboru ward in Ngala and 9 INDs who arrived from Mudu/Kaza ward of Dikwa LGA.

Gubio (Trigger: poor living conditions): 10 INDs arrived at Gubio town from neighbouring Gazabure and Gamowo wards due to poor living conditions.

Jere (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 26 INDs arrived at Muna Garage Camp from Mafa Camp B in Mafa LGA.

Kala Balge (Trigger: poor living conditions): 74 INDs arrived at Rann IDP Camp from Gulumba/Jukkuri ward of Bama LGA.
