


EMERGENCY TRACKING TOOL (ETT)

Summary

Nganzai (Triggger: attack): 1,453 INDs arrived at Gasarwa village from neighboring villages in Nganzai LGA due to recent attacks. 1,112 INDs have been forced to move out of Gajiram Central Primary School Camp to allow for renovations before schools open. There is an urgent need for shelter and other humanitarian assistance.

Gwoza (Triggers: Voluntary, poor living condition, military operations): 502 INDs arrived at Gwoza. these include 119 INDs arrivals at Wege Arrival Centre in Pulka, 171 arrivals at Wakane community from Mubi South in Adamawa and 212 arrivals at Gadamayo community.

Askira / Uba (Triggers: improved security, poor living condition, voluntary relocation): 108 new arrivals and 47 departures were recorded in Askira/Uba during the reporting period. These include 90 individuals (INDs) who arrived at the town from neighboring wards, 5 INDs who arrived from Jalingo in Taraba State, 13 INDs who arrived from Adamawa State, 41 INDs who left for Gwoza LGA and 6 INDs who left for Hong LGA in Adamawa State.

Bama (Triggers: voluntary relocation, military operation): 87 INDs arrived at Bama and 77 INDs left Bama during the reporting period. These include 68 arrivals at General Hospital Camp, 19 arrivals at Banki Camp, 9 departures from General Hospital Camp and 68 departures from Banki Camp.

Chibok (Triggers: voluntary relocation, improved security): 18 INDs left Chibok for Gumsuri/Misakurbudu ward in Damboa LGA.

Damboa (Triggers: Voluntary, poor living condition): 18 INDs arrived at Damboa during the reporting period. These include 9 arrivals at Abori Camp, 4 arrivals at General Hospital Camp Damboa and 5 arrivals at Damboa town.

Dikwa (Triggers: Voluntary, military operation): 14 INDs arrived at 20-Housing Estate Dikwa from Gulumba ward of Bama LGA.

Gubio (Trigger: attack): 4 INDs arrived at Bula Karaye community in Gubio from Fannari in Guzamala LGA, due to an attack in Fannari.

Konduga (Trigger: Voluntary relocation): 51 INDs arrived at Boarding Primary School Camp Konduga and 22 INDs left the Camp during the reporting period.

Kukawa (Trigger: Improved security): 42 INDs arrived at Kukawa town during the reporting period. These include 35 arrivals from Maiduguri M.C. LGA and 7 from Cross Kauwa village in Kukawa.

Lamurde (Trigger: Poor living condition): 10 INDs left Kaban community in Larmurde during the reporting. These include 4 INDs who left for Gwoza in Borno State and 6 INDs who left for Madagali LGA in Adamawa.

Madagali (Trigger: Poor living condition): 12 INDs arrived at Madagali town from nearby Nyibagol and Kabang villages.

Mafa (Triggers: Voluntary relocation, poor living condition): 55 INDs arrived at Mafa and 18 INDs left Mafa during the reporting period. These include 24 arrivals at Mafa Primary School Camp, 10 arrivals at Government Girls Secondary School (GGSS) Camp, 5 arrivals at Hausari Community, 16 arrivals at Ajari community, and 18 departures from Bulamari to Mafa town.

Michika (Trigger: Voluntary relocation): 9 INDs arrived at Luguhui community in Michika from Gombi LGA in Adamawa State.

Monguno (Trigger: attack): 315 INDs arrived at Monguno during the reporting period. These include 270 INDs who arrived at Government Secondary School (GSS) Camp and 45 INDs who arrived at Gana Ali Camp from Guzamala LGA due to an attack in Guzamala.

Mubi North (Trigger: Voluntary): 6 INDs left Mubi North for Gwoza Town.

Mubi South (Trigger: Voluntary): 16 INDs arrived at the town from nearby villages in Mubi South and 72 INDs left Burnt Brick Camp/Wuropatuje for Gwoza LGA in Borno State.

Ngala (Trigger: Voluntary): 23 INDs arrived at International School Camp Ngala from neighboring Fuye, Warshele and Logumane wards.
