
DISPLACEMENT

- The firth round of the Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM—October 2016) identified: 198,889
 IDPs (76%), 26,743 Unregistered Refugees (10%, and 36,068 Returnees (14%)
- 92% of the displaced population was displaced by the insurgency and 8% by flooding and other natural disasters.
- An estimated 45% of the current population was displaced in 2016 (January to October 2016). The remaining percentage is broken down as followed: 28% in 2015, 22% in 2014 and 5% before 2014.
- An estimated 72% of the displaced household population lives in host communities while 15% live in rented housing, 9% in spontaneous settlements, 2% in collective centers, and 2% in open-air spaces.


RETURN INTENTIONS HIGHLIGHTS

- 23% of displaced persons indicated their intention to return to their place of origin while 7% indicated that they would leave their area of displacement for another location, and 71% indicated their intention to remain at their displacement site.
- Three main reasons preventing displaced people from returning to their place of origin are: fear / trauma (46%), feeling secure in the village of displacement (18%), and the absence of armed forces in the area of origin (12%)
- Three top factors required to enable a return: presence of security forces in the area of origin (40%), provision of humanitarian assistance in the area of origin (23%), and improved access to basic services in the area of origin (14%).

FORESEEN PERIOD OF RETURN













REASONS FOR INTENDEING TO REMAIN IN THE AREA OF DISPLACEMENT
