OVERVIEW

The Area Baseline assessment provides granular data on the number and geographic location of officially recorded internally displaced persons (IDPs). Data collection for the Area Baseline assessment Round 16 took place between 31 October and 11 November across 21 oblasts and Kyiv city. In the areas covered, the number of recorded IDPs was collected for all 106 raions and 982 hromadas (75 per cent of all). In addition, gender disaggregated figures were provided across 66 per cent of hromadas— of those areas, 63 per cent of registered IDPs were females and 37 per cent were males.


This report assesses registered IDP presence at the hromada and oblast-levels, while also mapping the percentage change since the previous round. It further highlights the rate of change at the macro-regional level and charts the registered IDP figures at the raion-level across the previous 10 rounds.

IOM's glossary defines IDPs as persons or groups of persons who have been forced or obliged to flee or to leave their homes or places of habitual residence, in particular as a result of or in order to avoid the effects of armed conflict, situations of generalized violence, violations of human rights or natural or human-made disasters, and who have not crossed an internationally recognized state border. Operationally, for this assessment, interviewers define and understand IDPs as persons who officially registered as fleeing their habitual place of residence due to the current war in Ukraine.


KEY INSIGHTS


- Round 16 includes information from 982 out of 1,319 hromadas in the covered areas (74%).
- Among oblasts, Kharkivska (430,242), Dnipropetrovska (355,493) and Kyivska (335,517) have the highest number of displaced persons.
- At the raion level, Kyivska, Kharkivskyi, Zaporizkyi, Dniprovskyi and Lvivskyi host the highest number of recorded IDPs, with over 148,000 each.
- Of the total IDPs, the majority have been displaced from **Donetska**, **Kharkivska** and **Luhanska** oblasts.
- Out of the 155 cities/towns that reported IDP figures, Kyiv, Dnipro, Kharkiv, Zaporizhzhia and Lviv recorded the highest displacement figures.





Disclaimer: The data in this report was sourced from official IDP data recorded by hromada officials. As such, it likely represents an undercount of those who have been forced to flee their homes.

RECENT MOVEMENTS

Since the previous round, the official figures for IDPs have increased by nearly 95,000 (+2.5%). The largest increases in registered IDP presence were registered in Zaporizka (+7%), while a more moderate increase is observed in other Eastern oblasts. The situation in Eastern and frontline regions, however, remains fluid, as many reports indicate that individuals are fleeing from conflict zones and returning to liberated areas. Further information about mobility intentions can be found in the IOM General Population Survey.

Moderate increases are visible in the West of the country. However, these changes are mostly due to increased data coverage. Ivano-Frankivska oblast showed a substantial increase (+49%, 47,648) in the total number of registered IDPs. While hromadas in Ivano-Frankivska oblast that were covered in previous and current rounds did exhibit an increase in registered IDPs, this change amounted to around +15%.

Some oblasts in the Central macro-region reported a slight decrease in registered IDPs, including Khmelnytska (-1%) and Cherkaska (-2%). Deregistration of IDPs, however, do not necessarily imply an increase in returns.

TRENDS OVER TIME

Since August 2022, DTM data collection activities have covered all macro-regions* of Ukraine. Information on officially registered presence of IDPs is now available for all areas of the country for multiple consecutive rounds, enabling trends tracking through time.

The Eastern macro-region shows the largest increase in absolute terms, reaching almost 1 million registered IDPs as of the beginning of November. However, Kyiv City (+20%) and Southern oblasts (+35%) were by far the fastest growing areas in relative terms. Registered IDPs in Western Ukraine (+15%), on the other hand, increased partly because of expanded coverage of data collection activities in the region.

* The macro-regions include the following oblasts. WEST: Ivano-Frankivska, Volynska, Zakarpatska, Lvivska, Rivnenska, Temopilska, Chernivetska, Khmelnytska; CENTRE: Vinnytska, Kirovohradska, Poltvaska, Cherkaska; EAST: Dnipropetrovska, Kharkivska; NORTH: Chernihinska, Kyivska, Sumska, Zhytomyrska; SOUTH: Odeska, Mykolaivska. Kyiv City is counted separately.

METHODOLOGY AND FURTHER INFORMATION

Data for the Area Baseline Assessment is collected through a Key Informant (KI) network within the area of coverage. DTM field team work continuously to maintain and expand their KI network while triangulating and verifying recorded figures on displacement in each hromada.
