FLOOD RESPONSE BASELINE ASSESSMENT - SINDH PROVINCE

OCTOBER 2022











1. INTRODUCTION

Storms and heavy monsoon rains in Pakistan have caused widespread flooding and landslides across the country. According to the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), up to 33 million people have been affected by the floods since mid-June 2022 and a total of 85 districts have been labelled by the Government of Pakistan as 'calamity-hit', as of 17 October 2022.¹ According to the NDMA Daily Situation Report No.126, 24 districts in Sindh province are calamity-hit and an estimated total of 14,563,770 people are affected by the floods.² Besides that, 1.9 million houses are reported to be damaged in Sindh province alone. However, the number of temporarily displaced persons (TDPs) were yet to be confirmed.

Given the number of calamity-hit districts and the number of affected people, IOM's Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) decided to roll out its Baseline Assessment. This was done following coordination and approval from the Provincial Disaster Management Authority (PDMA) Sindh. The purpose of the Baseline Assessment is to map out the estimated number of TDPs and returning TDPs at union council level, while obtaining a master list of villages with displacement and returns to guide both humanitarian and recovery efforts. As a start, IOM deployed its Baseline Assessment across the top 5 districts reporting the highest displacement in Sindh province. These districts are Khairpur, Larkana, Dadu, Umer Kot and Mirpur Khas. The Baseline Assessment was thus carried out across all 289 union councils that exist under these 5 targeted districts.

2. METHODOLOGY

The Baseline Assessment was conducted at key informant level through Focus Group Discussions (FGDs), Direct Observation and Direct Interviews with Key Informants (mainly union council government officials) as they were able to estimate displacement and return figures at union council level. Registration lists, aid distribution lists and other records of displaced populations were utilised wherever available.

Information was triangulated with other key informants such as religious leaders, village leaders, TDPs, health workers and teachers, and cross checked through the direct observation of DTM enumerators.

It is important to note that further verification is needed at village level, as the Baseline Assessment is done at a broader union council level. The training of enumerators was held on 25 September 2022 in both Sukkur and Hyderabad, and data collection was carried out from 26 September to 2 October 2022.

Following this exercise, DTM is planning to roll out its Community Needs Identification Tool (CNIT). Data for this exercise will mainly be collected through focus group discussions comprising of TDPs.

4. TOP 5 DISTRICTS WITH DISPLACEMENT: SINDH PROVINCE

Through the Baseline Assessment Round 1, IOM DTM teams evaluated the number of TDPs across all union councils in the top 5 districts with highest displacement in Sindh Province. A total of 289 union councils were assessed between 26 September to 2 October 2022.

DTM identified that there are an estimated total of 1,502,045 TDPs comprising of 231,630 households displaced due to the floods in the top 5 districts in Sindh Province.³

The 5 districts that were assessed include **Khairpur**, **Larkana**, **Dadu**, **Umer Kot and Mirpur Khas**. As the coverage is limited to 5 districts in this pilot round, it should be noted that the key finding of 1.5 million TDPs does not represent the total number of TDPs throughout Sindh Province.


Khairpur district witnessed the most displacement with a total of 617,850 temporarily displaced persons (TDPs)

or 94,001 TDP households. This constitutes 41 per cent of the total number of TDPs identified by DTM.

The district with the second highest displacement was Dadu district with 285,564 TDPs or 39,757 TDP households (19% of total displacement identified). This matches against observations where many union councils remained flooded and were only accessible by boat. Meanwhile, Mirpur Khas district hosted 272,402 TDPs or 43,505 TDP households, which represents 18 per cent of the total displacement identified.

At union council level, the locations with the highest displacement were Drib Mehar Shah (72,235 TDPs), Sagyoon (72,215 TDPs) and Ripri (72,029 TDPs) in Khaipur district, Torr (40,400 TDPs) in Dadu district and Baphu (37,103 TDPs) in Khaipur district. 5. TOP 5 DISTRICTS WITH RETURN: SINDH PROVINCE

In the same 5 districts of Khairpur, Larkana, Dadu, Umer Kot and Mirpur Khas, IOM DTM teams also evaluated the number of TDPs who have returned to their places of origin.

At the end of the assessment, DTM identified a total of 653,738 returning TDPs (103,644 households) who were initially displaced due to floods across the 5 target districts in Sindh Province.⁴ Of this total, 55 per cent of returning TDPs returned within the same union council while the remaining 45 per cent returned from another union council.


The districts with the highest number of returning TDPs were Umerkot and Mirpur Khas, with 196,695 returning TDPs (34,519 households) and 188,225 returning TDPs (29,038 households) respectively. A large majority (95%) of returns happened within the same union council in Mirpur Khas district. Meanwhile, in Umer

Kot district, only 40 per cent of returns were within the same union council, while the remaining 60 per cent of returns happened from another union council back to the union council of origin.

The top union councils with the highest returns were Koonjeli/Talho Jonejo (82,500 returning TDPs) in Umerkot district, Manghanwari (60,070 returning TDPs) in Khairpur district, Dirgh Bala (30,000 returning TDPs) in Dadu district, Jhuluri (28,006 returning TDPs) in Mirpur Khas district and Burira (21,300 returning TDPs) in Dadu district.

A majority of returns occurred between 1 to 2 weeks (45%) and between 2 to 4 weeks (30%) before the survey. In Khairpur district, a considerable portion of returns happened 1 to 2 weeks before the assessment (77%). For the full list of districts and union councils with returns, kindly refer to the annex.




6. LONG-TERM PLANS AND NEEDS

Almost all union councils (272 or 94%) indicated that the plan for the TDPs would be for them to return after flood waters receded, while TDPs in 1 per cent of union councils would relocate. The 3 union councils (1%) that indicated that relocation was the plan were found in Makhdoom Bilawal in Dadu district, Ustad Atta Muhammad Hami in Khaipur district and Karani in Larkana district.

The plan for TDPs in the remaining 14 union councils (5%) is unknown, whereby half of these union councils are in Dadu district which is still flooded as of the time of reporting.

Across most union councils (271 or 94%), shelter was the most cited need to support TDPs after the floods. WASH was cited as the second most common need to support TDPs after the floods as found in 235 union councils (81%), but closely followed by agriculture across 234 union councils (81%).

Meanwhile, health services were cited as the fourth most common need across 232 union councils (80%) and livelihoods ranked as the fifth most common need after the floods in 217 union councils (75%).
