



OVERVIEW

The Registered IDP Area Baseline Assessment provides granular data on the number and geographic location of officially registered internally displaced persons (IDPs). Data collection for the Area Baseline assessment Round 19 took place between 12 and 25 December 2022 across 22 oblasts¹ and Kyiv city. In the areas covered, the number of recorded IDPs was collected for all 111 raions and 940 hromadas (71 per cent of all hromadas in the covered oblasts). In addition, gender disaggregated figures were provided across 52 per cent of hromadas – in those areas, 62 per cent of registered IDPs were females and 38 per cent were males. Since Round 18, data collection has expanded to include parts of Donetsk oblast as well.

This report assesses registered IDP presence at the raion level, while also mapping the percentage change since the previous round. It further highlights the rate of change at the macro-regional level and charts the registered IDP figures at the raion-level across the previous 8 rounds.

IOM's glossary defines IDPs as persons or groups of persons who have been forced or obliged to flee or to leave their homes or places of habitual residence, in particular as a result of or in order to avoid the effects of armed conflict, situations of generalised violence, violations of human rights or natural or human-made disasters, and who have not crossed an internationally recognized state border. Operationally, for this assessment, IOM define and understand IDPs as persons who officially registered as fleeing their habitual place of residence due to the current war in Ukraine.

KEY INSIGHTS

- Round 19 includes information from 940 out of 1,319 hromadas in the covered areas (71%).
- Among oblasts, Kharkivska (442,584), Dnipropetrovska (363,729) and Kyivska (337,638) have the highest number of formally registered IDPs.
- At the raion level, Kyivska, Kharkivskiy, Zaporizkyy, Dniprovskyy and Lvivskyy host the highest number of registered IDPs, with over 130,000 each.
- Of the total registered IDPs, the majority have been displaced from Donetsk, Kharkivska and Zaporizka oblasts.




Round 19 registered IDP Presence per Raion, as of 25 December 2022

RECENT MOVEMENTS




Since the previous round, the aggregated registration figures reported for IDPs have decreased by nearly 2,700 (-1%). The highest decreases are recorded in Lvivska (-2%) and Poltavka (-2%).

Despite the sustained strikes and conflict-related violence in Eastern and Southern Ukraine, IDP registration keeps growing the fastest in these areas - suggesting that new displacements continue to be largely intra-regional. At the same time, westward movements away from the frontline appear to be stable. A moderate increase in the total number of registered IDPs is visible in the Centre of the country. In particular, Kirovohradska oblast showed a substantial rise in registered IDPs (+5%, 4,526). However, a change in the number of registered IDPs may not fully account for all IDP movements to or from a location of displacement.

TRENDS OVER TIME

Since August 2022, the DTM Baseline covers all macro-regions⁴ of Ukraine. Information on officially registered presence of IDPs is now available for all areas of the country for multiple consecutive rounds, enabling IOM to track trends through time.

Since October 28 (Round 15), the Eastern macro-region shows the largest increase in absolute terms (+80,000), reaching 1 million registered IDPs as of the beginning of December due to an increase in the coverage of this assessment. In percentage terms, due to the increase, the Southern oblasts (+31%) and Kyiv City (+13%) were the fastest growing areas in terms of new IDP registrations. The number of registered IDPs in Western Ukraine (+5%) increased partly because of expanded coverage since round 16 data collection activities in the region. In particular, coverage in Lvivska, Ivano-Frankivska and Zakarpatska, has increased substantially since October.

METHODOLOGY AND FURTHER INFORMATION

Data for the Area Baseline Assessment is collected through a key informant (KI) network within the area of coverage. The DTM field team work continuously to maintain and expand their KI network while triangulating and verifying recorded figures on registered displacement in each hromada.
