

Displacement of populations in the Jerusalem 7 neighborhood (Croix-de-Bouquets)

The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to collect information on large and sudden population movements as well as security and climactic emergencies. Information is collected through phone interviews with key informants and direct observation. This dashboard presents information on population displacements that occurred on 22 January 2023, in the Jerusalem 7 neighborhood located in the district of Croix-de-Bouquets (West Department), following armed attacks.

The neighborhood of Jerusalem 7, located in the second section of Varreux, in the district of Croix-des-Bouquets (West Department), were targeted by an attack by armed persons on 22 January 2023. In addition to losses of human lives, burning and looting of houses, this event caused the displacement of approximately 100 households comprising between 500 and 800 individuals who fled to several neighborhoods, in particular Shada-Tiginen, Casimir and Lizon located in the first section of Varreux (District of Croix-de-Bouquets), Lillavois-Cesselesse and Santo in the second section of Varreux (same district) as well as Delmas 33 and 75 in the first section Saint-Martin of the district of Delmas.

IOM teams are collecting more information on these displaced people and will share related reports when available.

Furthermore, it should be noted that key informants reported that the armed persons who attacked Jerusalem 7 neighborhood forced several other residents of the neighborhood not to flee.
