
Summary of displacement in the Lac province in December 2022


The purpose of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to collect information on large and sudden population movements as well as on security and climate emergencies. This dashboard provides information on movements which occurred during the period from 07 to 24 December 2022, in Lac Province.

During 2022, several security and climatic incidents have been observed in the Lake Province, resulting in thousands of displacements. A total of 1,304 households (5,730 individuals) were affected by displacement in December 2022. Furthermore, all these persons were previously local communities before these new displacements. Most of these displacements were caused by river flooding (63%) and armed attacks (37%). Indeed, the majority of these persons (66%) took refuge in localities situated in other souspréfectures compared to their places of provenance (see Table 1). The most reported immediate needs were food, shelter and non-food items.

Displaced persons by host sous-préfecture and reasons for displacement in December 2022


