# REGISTERED IDP AREA BASELINE ASSESSMENT **UKRAINE - ROUND 20 JANUARY 2023**



#### **OVFRVIFW**

The Registered IDP Area Baseline Assessment provides granular data on the number and geographic location of officially registered internally displaced persons (IDPs). Data collection for the Area Baseline assessment Round 20 took place between 1 and 31 January 2023 across 23 oblasts and Kyiv city. In the areas covered, the number of recorded IDPs was collected for all 107 raions and 967 hromadas (67% of all hromadas in the covered oblasts). In addition, gender disaggregated figures were provided across 47 per cent of hromadas.


This report assesses registered IDP presence at the raion level, while also mapping the percentage change since the previous round. It further highlights

IOM's glossary defines IDPs as persons or groups of persons who have been forced or obliged to flee or to leave their homes or places of habitual residence, in particular as a result of or in order to avoid the effects of armed conflict, situations of generalised violence, violations of human rights or natural or human-made disasters, and who have not crossed an internationally recognized state border. Operationally, for this assessment, IOM define and understand IDPs as persons who officially registered as fleeing their habitual place of residence due to the current war in Ukraine.

#### **KEY INSIGHTS**

- Round 20 includes information from 967 out of 1,434 hromadas in the covered areas (67%).
- Kharkivska (456,946), Dnipropetrovska Among oblasts. (367,089) and Kyivska (336,814) have the highest number of formally registered IDPs.
- At the raion level, Kharkivskyi, Kyivska and Dniprovskyi host the highest number of registered IDPs, with over 160,000 each.
- Of the total registered IDPs, the majority have been displaced from Donetska, Kharkivska and Luhanska oblasts.






Disclaimer: The data in this report was sourced from official IDP data recorded by. As such, it likely represents an undercount of those who have been de facto forced to flee their homes.

### CHANGE IN REGISTERED IDP FIGURES

Since Round 19 (25 December 2022), the total registered IDP population has increased by 1,291 individuals. Oblasts in the east and south of Ukraine all recorded an increased registered IDP population, with Donetska recording a nine per cent increase (3,556) and Odeska recording a six per cent increase (7,319). The largest absolute increases were recorded in Kharkivska (14,362, a 3% increase) and Kyiv city (11,440, a 5% increase).

Across western and central Ukraine, the majority of oblasts recorded a moderate decrease in the registered IDP population (ranging from -1 to -5%). A notable outlier is Rivnenska, where an actualisation of the IDP register in the oblast at the end of 2022 is reflected in a reduction of 24,607 IDPs (-30%).

#### METHODOLOGY AND FURTHER INFORMATION

Data for the Area Baseline Assessment is collected through a key informant (KI) network within the area of coverage. The DTM field team work continuously to maintain and expand their KI network while triangulating and verifying recorded figures on registered displacement in each hromada. case of questions or feedback please contact <u>DTMUkraine@iom.int</u>.

#### DTM Coverage and Registered IDP Presence by Oblast

DTM endeavours to collect data on the registered IDP population in all territories under the control of the Government of Ukraine. The table below demonstrates the coverage of the baseline assessment by percentage of raions. For more insight on displacement trends and a sectoral analysis of needs, see <u>IOM Internal Displacement Report (General Population Survey)</u>, which provides national and macro-region level estimates and insights on de-facto displacement (registered and unregistered IDPs) and needs using phone surveys and a randomised sampling approach.

In Round 20, registered IDPs recorded in hromadas that are not currently under the control of the government of Ukraine have been excluded, as it is not possible to verify their location.
