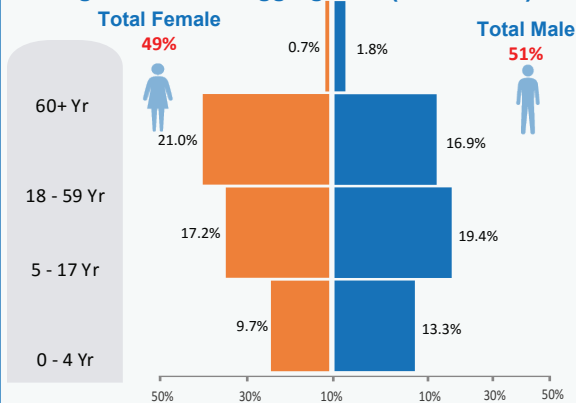

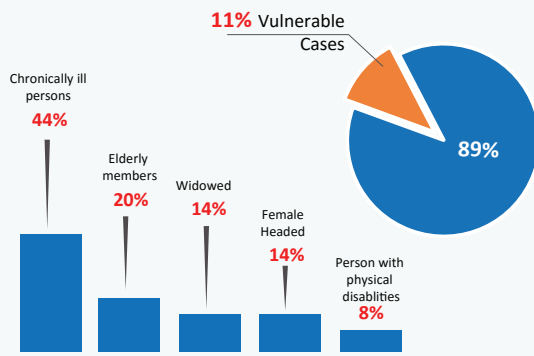

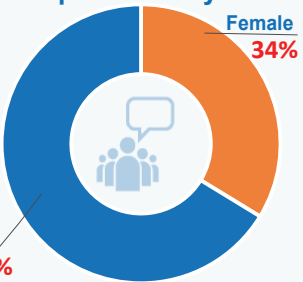
Age-Gender Disaggregation (Individuals)



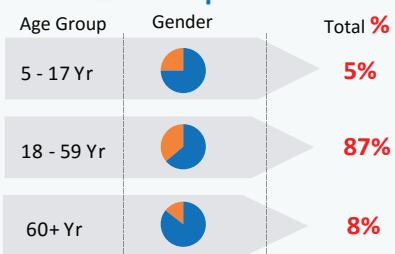
Vulnerable Cases Reported



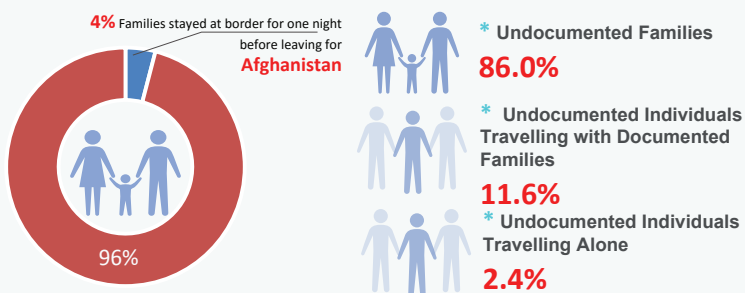
Respondents by Gender



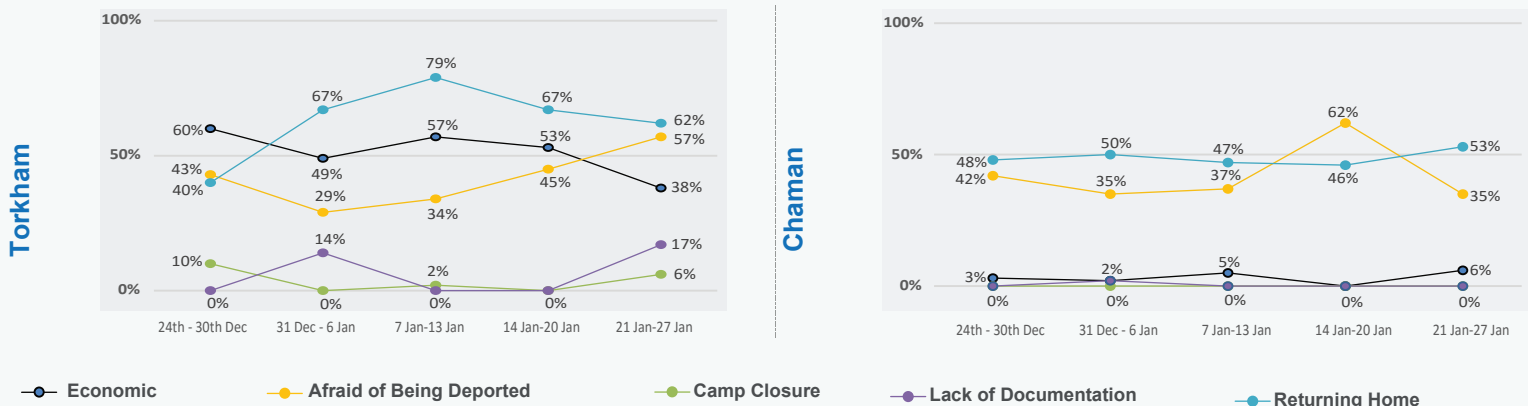
Age Group of Respondents



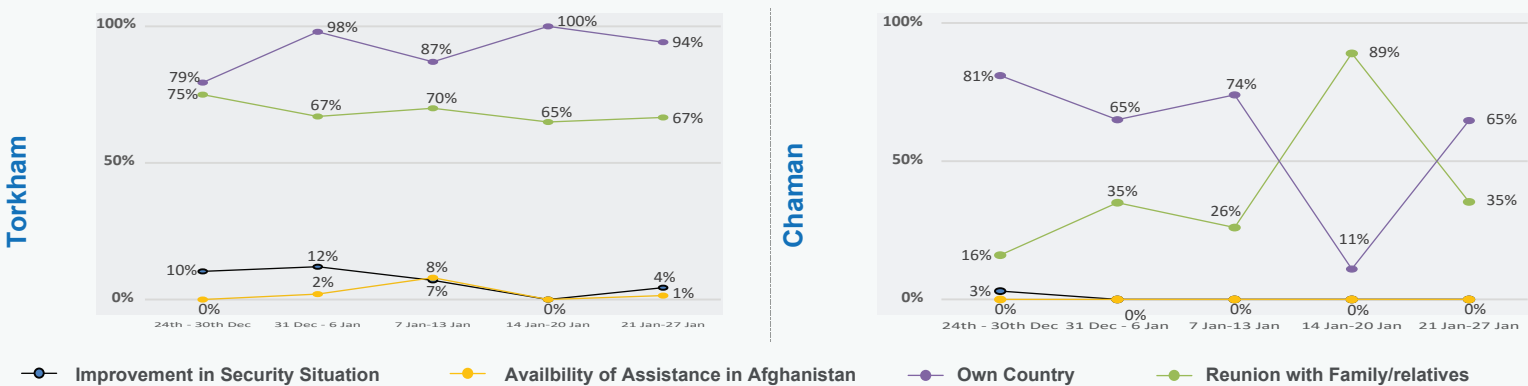

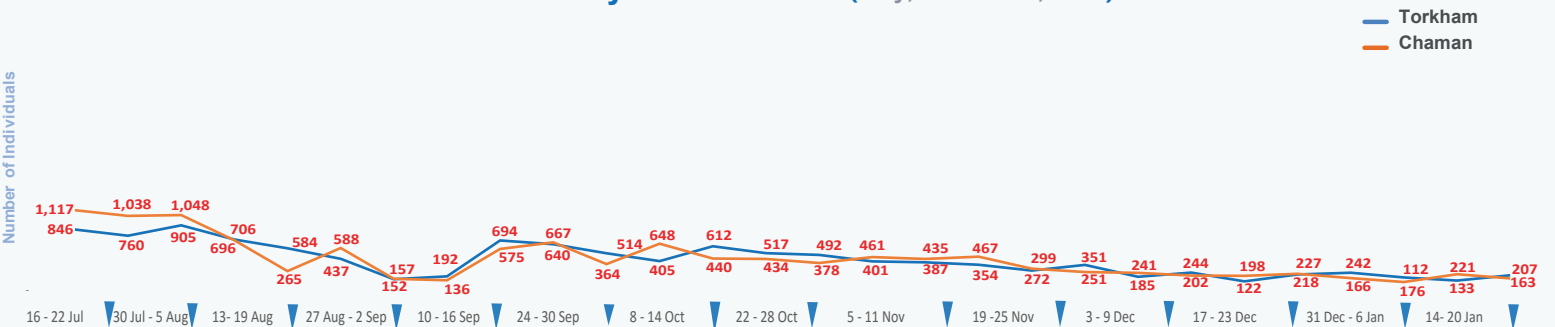

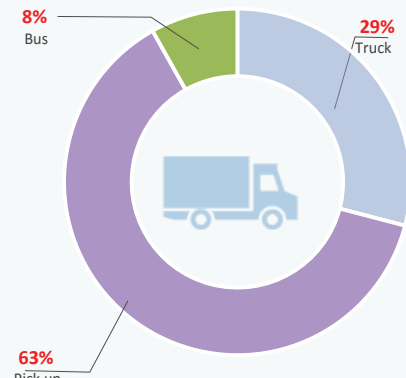

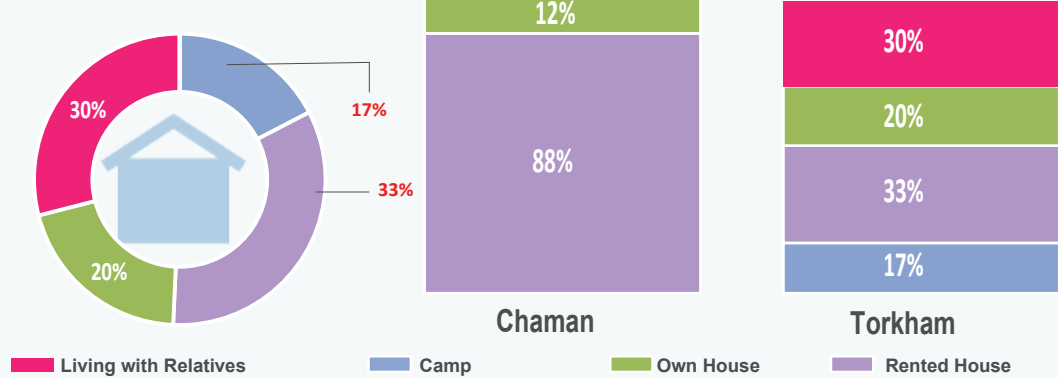

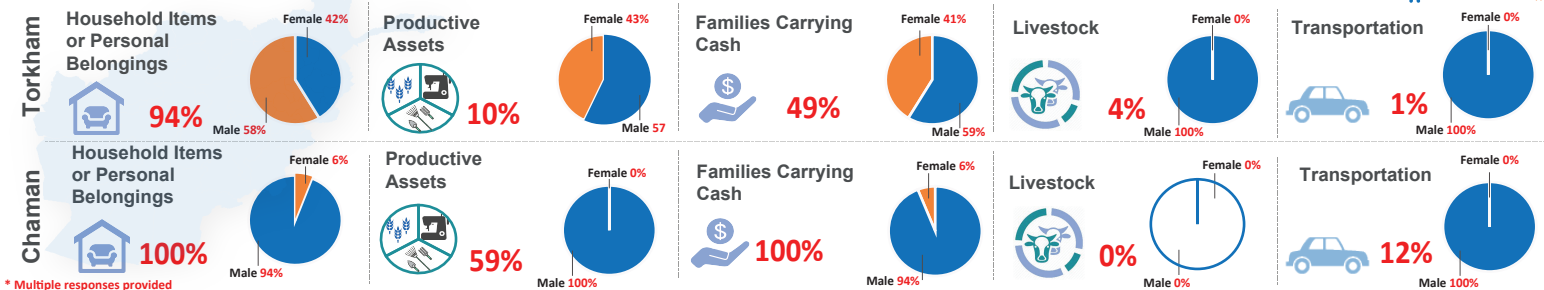

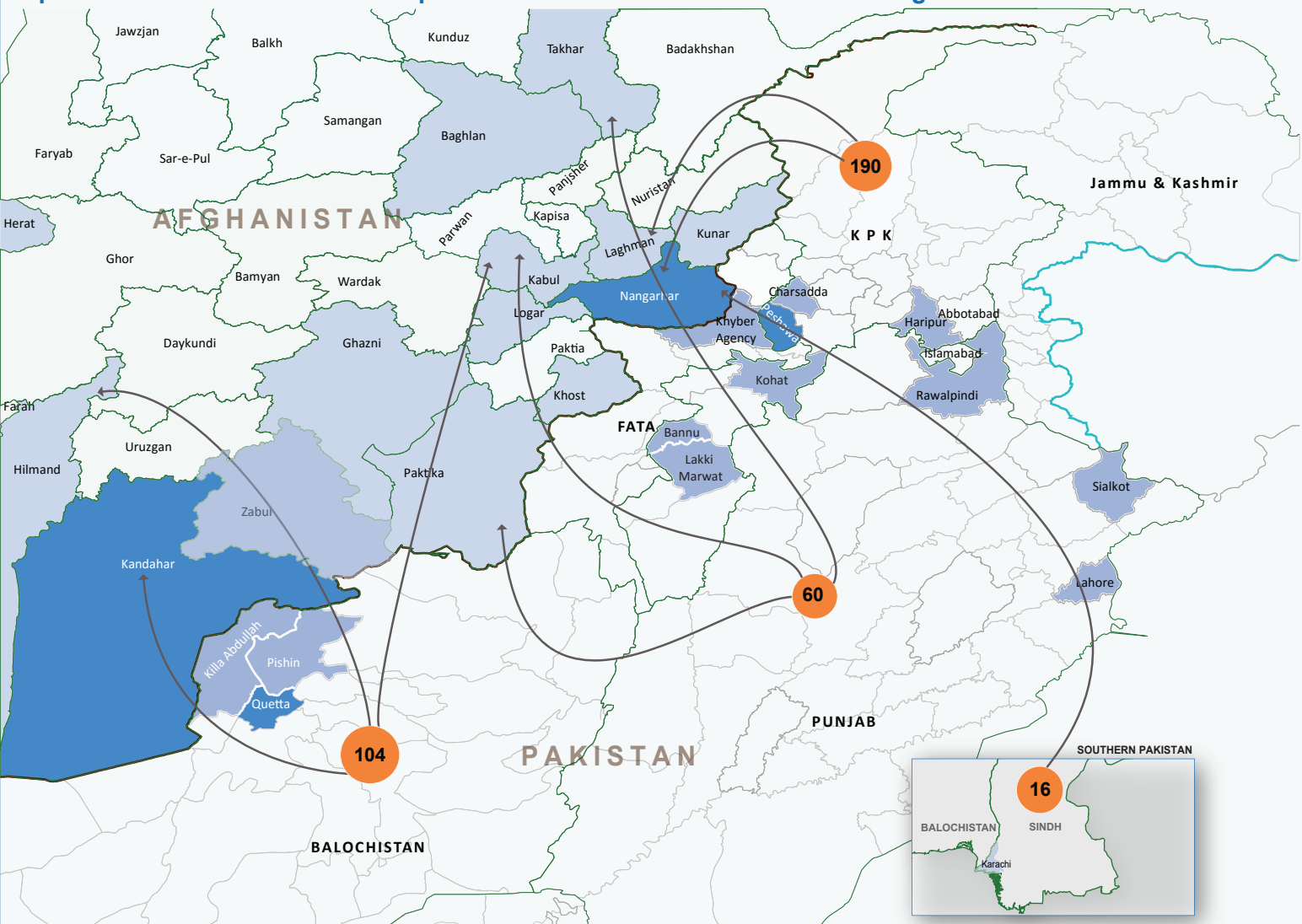
Living Conditions in Afghanistan
