

DISPLACEMENT IN DISPUTED AREAS


From 15 to 24 October 2017

As of 24 October (8 am):

● Total of **165,780** individuals currently displaced since the disputed areas bordering the KRI were handed over from the Kurdish Peshmerga to the Iraqi Security Forces beginning 15 October 2017

IOM's Displacement Tracking Matrix has been monitoring displacement movements related to this crisis since October 15, when Iraqi Security Forces began moving into disputed areas previously held by Kurdish forces. The situation remains very fluid, with most of the displacement patterns lasting only 24-48 hours

Number of IDPs by main districts of origin




