

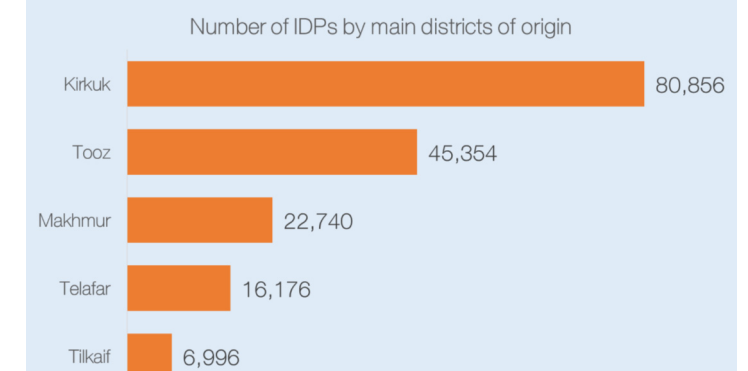
## DISPLACEMENT IN DISPUTED AREAS

From 15 to 31 October 2017

As of 31 October (8 am):

● Total of **184,146** individuals currently displaced since the disputed areas bordering the KRI were handed over from the Kurdish Peshmerga to the Iraqi Security Forces beginning 15 October 2017

IOM's Displacement Tracking Matrix has been monitoring displacement movements related to this crisis since October 15, when Iraqi Security Forces began moving into disputed areas previously held by Kurdish forces. The situation remains very fluid, with many of the displacement patterns lasting only 24-48 hours.

Number of IDPs breakdown by district of current displacement:

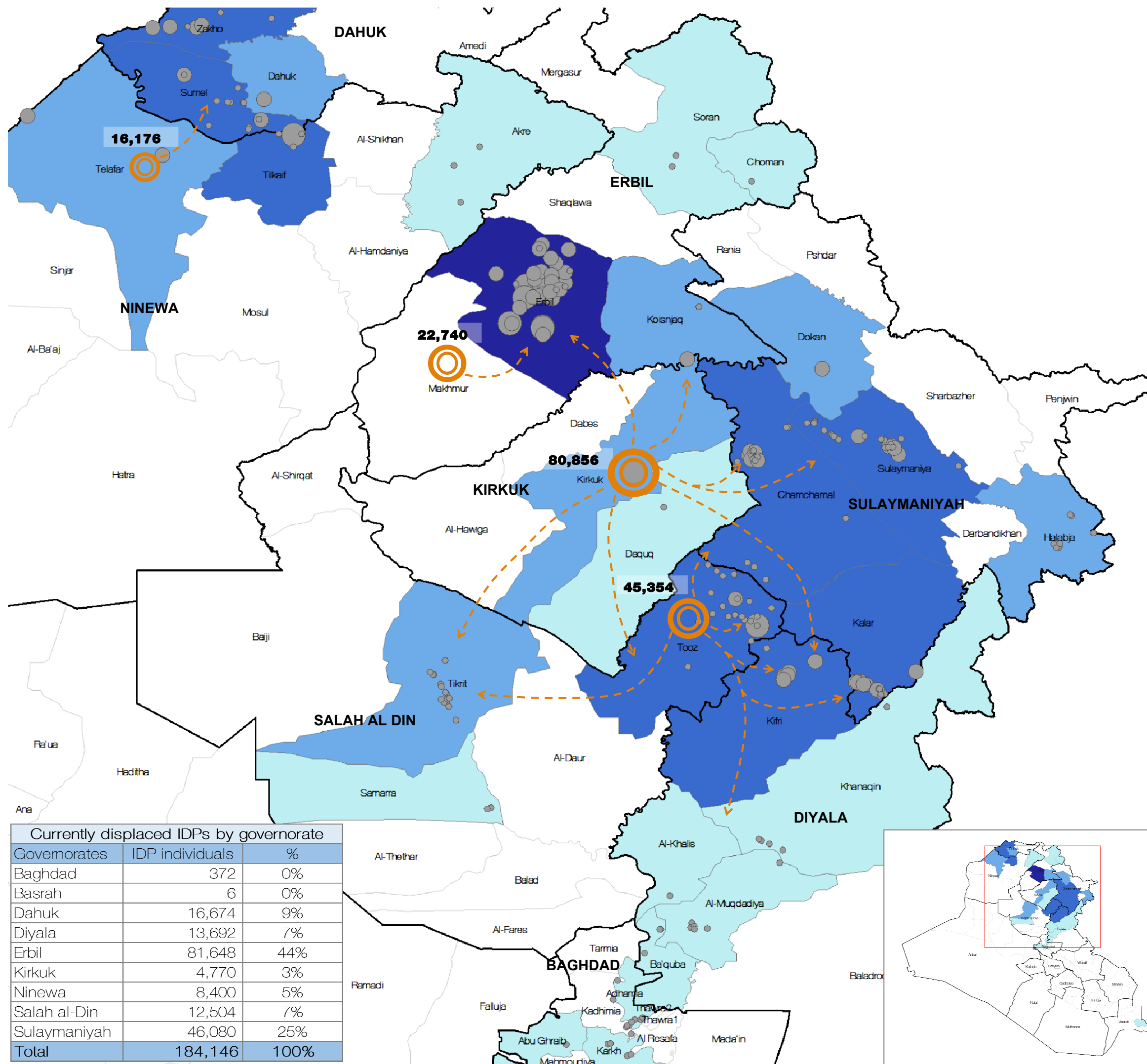
