



## DISPLACEMENT IN DISPUTED AREAS



Total of **182,724** individuals currently displaced from the disputed areas.

To date, there are **168,264** returnees from this crisis, 89% of whom returned to Kirkuk district.

IOM's Displacement Tracking Matrix has been monitoring displacement movements related to this crisis since October 15, when Iraqi Security Forces began moving into disputed areas previously held by Kurdish forces. The situation remains very fluid, with many of the displacement patterns lasting a matter of days.

Number of IDPs breakdown by district of current displacement:


