




TOTAL REGISTRATIONS ON ARRIVAL IN THE WESTERN BALKANS







MIGRANT RECEPTION FACILITIES IN THE WESTERN BALKANS SNAPSHOT



MIGRANTS MAPPED OUTSIDE RECEPTION






