

As a result of armed clashes in Sebha, 80 households (approximately 400 individuals) have been displaced to private and public buildings in the center of the city, with a further 60 households (300 individuals) displaced to the Baladiya of Murzuq.

The main reported needs of the displaced population in Sebha are drinking water, baby milk, diapers, sanitation and hygiene (WASH), food items, mattresses, blankets and cleaning materials. The reported needs in Murzuq are water, hygiene kits, baby milk, diapers, food, medical assistance, mattresses and blankets.

The DTM field team will continue to monitor the situation.
