



KEY MESSAGES

- This week there were 15 new arrivals through Dollow checkpoints and Zero Exits was recorded. The number of arrivals reported this week was higher than the numbers recorded last week; the key driving factors for displacements in to Dollow this week were lack of food (100%)
- The zero exit and high entry can be attributed as farmers have not yet harvested their crops since the onset of *Gu* rainy season,
- Unlike the previous weeks all the new arrivals came from Ethiopia (80%).
- Due to unavailability of spaces at Kabasa IDPs, all the new arrivals settle at Qansaxley IDPs settlements
