Movements

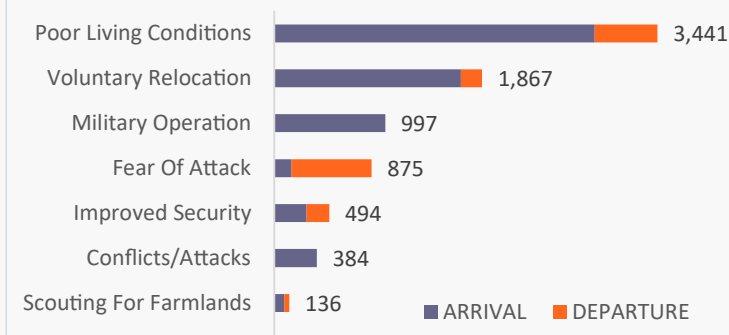


Within the period of 20 – 26 June 2018, a total of 8,194 movements were recorded, including 6,472 arrivals and 1,722 departures at locations in Askira/Uba, Bama, Biu, Chibok, Damboa, Demsa, Dikwa, Fufore, Girei, Gombi, Guzamala, Gwoza, Hawul, Hong, Jere, Kala/Balge,

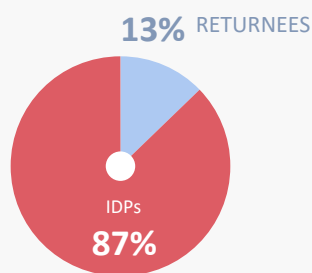
Konduga, Kukawa, Madagali, Mafa, Magumeri, Maiha, Michika, Mobbar, Monguno, Mubi-North, Mubi-South, Ngala, Numan, Yola-North and Yola-South Local Government Areas (LGAs) of Adamawa and Borno States.

Assessments identified the following main triggers of movements: poor living conditions (42%), voluntary relocation (23%), military operations (12%), fear of attacks (11%), improved security (6%), ongoing conflict (5%) and IDPs scouting for farmlands (1%).

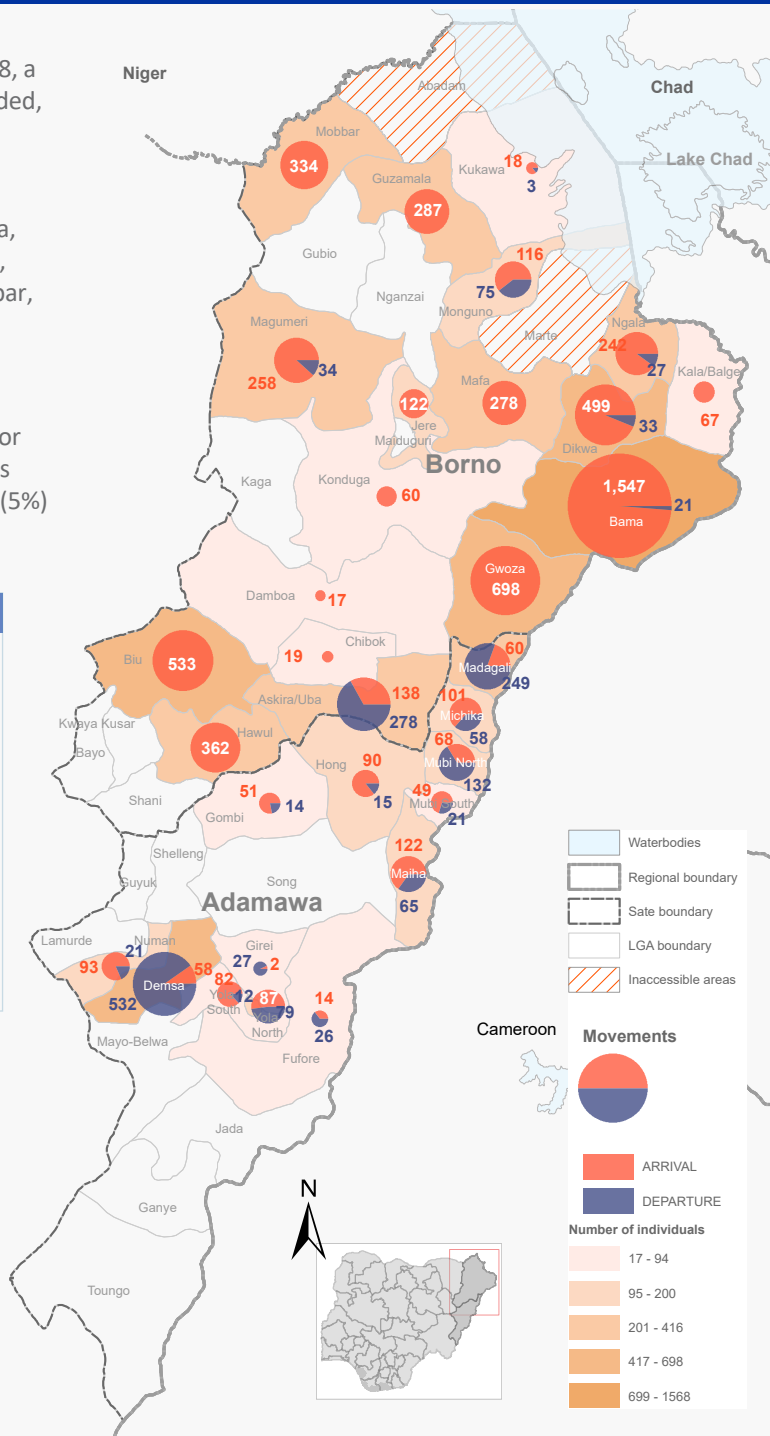
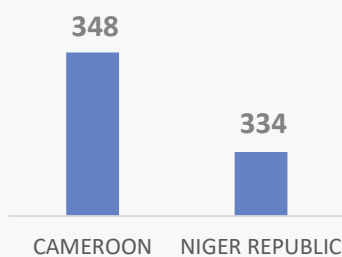
Number of individuals by movement triggers

Summary of major movements

Bama: 1,547 arrivals and 21 departures were recorded in Bama LGA. These include 1,114 arrivals at GSSSS Camp from Soye/Abbaram wards of Bama, 285 arrivals at Banki Camp from Kote/Kumshe ward of Bama, 148 arrivals at Banki Camp from Marwa in Cameroon and 21 individuals who left GSSSS Camp for Pulka. The main movement triggers include poor living conditions and voluntary relocation.

Gwoza: 698 arrivals were recorded in Gwoza LGA. These include 538 arrivals at the Transit Camp in Pulka and 160 arrivals at Bulabulin/Wakane ward. The main movement triggers include military operations along Kirawa axis of Bama and poor living condition.

Demsa: 58 arrivals and 532 departures were recorded in Demsa LGA. These include 58 individuals who arrived at Borrong/Nasarawo ward, 523 individuals who left Nasarawo ward of Demsa LGA for Numan LGA due to fears of attack and 9 individuals who left Borrong ward for Kwayine due to poor living conditions.

Biu: 533 arrivals were recorded in Biu LGA. The arrivals include 434 individuals who arrived at the town from surrounding wards due to poor living conditions and 99 arrivals at Zara Wiyaku ward from Chibok LGA (69 individuals arriving due to military operations) and Hawul LGA (30 individuals).
