
Movements

Within the period of 13 – 19 June 2018, a total of 3,412 movements were recorded, including 2,913 arrivals and 499 departures at locations in Askira/Uba, Bama, Biu, Chibok, Damboa, Demsa, Dikwa, Fufore, Girei, Gombi, Gubio, Guzamala, Gwoza, Hawul, Hong, Madagali, Mafa, Magumeri, Maiha, Michika, Mobbar, Monguno, Mubi-North, Mubi-South, Ngala, Nganzai, Numan, Yola-North and Yola-South Local Government Areas (LGAs) of Adamawa and Borno States.




Assessments identified the following main triggers of movements: poor living conditions (35%), military operations (25%), voluntary relocation (25%), farming activities (7%), improved security (4%), ongoing conflict (3%) and fear of attacks (1%).



Number of individuals by movement triggers

Summary of major movements

Bama: 920 arrivals were recorded in Bama LGA. These include 741 arrivals at GSSSS Camp and 179 arrivals at Banki Camp. The arrivals were from Gulumba, Abbaram and Soye axis of Bama LGA, due to military operations in these areas and poor living conditions.

Gwoza: 292 arrivals were recorded in Gwoza LGA. These include 174 arrivals at the Transit Camp in Pulka, 88 arrivals at Hausari/Gadamayo ward and 30 arrivals at Bulabulin/Gwoza Wakane ward. The main movement triggers include poor living conditions and improved security.

Dikwa: 269 individuals arrived at FOB Screening Centre in Dikwa LGA. These include 169 arrivals from Afaye and Boboshe wards of Dikwa LGA, 91 arrivals from Gulumba ward of Bama LGA and 9 arrivals from Warshela ward of Ngala LGA. The main movement triggers include poor living conditions and military operations.

Askira/Uba: 165 arrivals and 97 departures were recorded in Askira/Uba LGA. The arrivals include 130 individuals who moved to the town from surrounding wards due to poor living conditions, 17 arrivals from Mubi-South LGA of Adamawa State, 11 arrivals from Gwoza LGA and 7 arrivals from Nasarawa State. The departures include 58 individuals who left Askira/Uba for Adamawa State, 19 individuals who left for Bauchi State, 16 individuals who left for Gwoza LGA and 4 individuals who left for Chibok LGA. The main movement triggers include poor living conditions and voluntary relocation.
