



#### Population Demographics\*





##### Camp Needs/ Gaps

Camp Management: Lack of trained camp managers.

##### Response

- Protection Cluster conducted 2 batches of CCCM Training to 80 CSWDO & ARMM camp managers to be deployed on rotation on 27 June 2017.

Shelter: Congested evacuation centers.

- CCCM Cluster came up with the Alternative Evacuation Space (AES) concept to address congestion in ECs. To be implemented on first week of July.

WASH: Case of E. Coli in Tibanga Gym EC, no drainage system in Buru-un School of Fisheries EC, insufficient latrines.

- DOH treated the tap source to make water safe for drinking.


Education: No Temporary Learning Spaces, no informal education conducted, students are unable to continue schooling due to security reasons.

- DepEd and Education Cluster are mapping out the unenrolled IDP students for appropriate assistance




Protection: No VAW-CP awareness sessions, no protection referral pathway information posters.


#### Population Demographics\*





#### Gaps / Needs

Camp Management: Lack of trained camp managers.

Shelter: Congested evacuation centers.

Food and NFI: No supplemental feeding for children and for lactating/pregnant women in 7 of the 11 ECs in Balo-i. Not all IDPs received NFIs in 7 of the 11 ECs.

WASH: Drainage system not working properly or no drainage at all in 8 of the ECs. Long queueing due to insufficient water taps, latrines and bathing cubicles.

Health: No MHPSS conducted in 8 ECs. Nearest Health Facilities in 9 ECs is 200m to 4km away from EC.

Education: No Temporary Learning Spaces in 9 of the 11 ECs. No informal education activities conducted.

Protection: Lack of IDs. No 24hr security in 6 ECs. No VAW-CP awareness sessions conducted, confidential VAW services available, and monitoring of GBV-CP in all of the sites. No protection referral pathway information posted in all of the sites. No protective facilities are available in most of the sites. Worship areas are requested by IDPs inside the evacuation centers.


